The life cycle of the embryo is quite magical! First, is the point of fertilization. Then, is the germinal stage of 2 to 3 weeks,

Then from the 3rd to the 8th week, is the embryonic period when our body starts getting formed. Thereafter, from the 9th week till our birth, is the foetal period. Once the fertilized egg has life, it multiplies into 2 cells, then 4 cells, then 8 and 16, often referred to next as a blastocyst. Month after month, the embryo remains alive with the umbilical cord that nourishes it from its mother. But there is no doubt that the baby has life. It moves, it kicks as it lives within.

All species that are alive on earth have their own unique pre-birth life cycle. Some of it is scientifically known, some imagined. Don't we look in awe when a little egg hatches and a chick is born? Have you ever experienced the joy when your pet dog delivers a litter in about 60 days after the act of fertilization? All this is magic that is beyond human logic!

Although it is so obvious that life is throbbing all around us, we fail to realize that we are *the very life* that throbs *in* the body. We are not the body that we appear to be. When we contemplate further and realize this truth, we become enlightened. Nobody in this world knows when we are going to die. Death can happen all of a sudden. Although human beings have a life span of up to 100 years, which means that they can easily live up to 100 years, the average life expectancy today is about 70 to 75 years. In advanced countries where health care is good, people live up to 90 and in countries where there is no good air and water, people die at 50. Whether it is 50, 70 or 90, the fact is that death is certain. Every living body must die. This is how life has been created on earth. The human being experiences death in less than 100 years, a dog in 10 to 15 years, a butterfly in 10 to 15 days, and some flies live for just one day. Whatever be the living creature, every animate being

must die. At death, the life inside a living creature departs. Because of this, the body is cremated or buried. It is of no use and is returned to dust.

What actually happens at that moment of death is unknown to man. Man can die naturally, out of some disease or even due to an accident. If the heart stops functioning, and the blood does not take oxygen to the brain, man is considered dead. So also, if the brain does not function, this can lead to multi-organ failure and man can die. Whatever be the sequence or cause, no man can escape death. While science is so busy trying to understand the biological and scientific aspects of death, very few people ponder on the spiritual aspect of death.

What actually happens at death? Science may not accept it, but the truth is, that spark of energy that came alive 9 months before our birthday, left. Then, there was no breath, there was death. Because we do not realize the truth of our birth, we are not able to comprehend the Spiritual reality of death. Because we celebrate a birthday that is fake, we don't awake to the truth that we are not that baby who was born and who was later called Sheela or John. We are that spark of Energy that was conceived 9 months before. When we realize this, we can understand death much better. The body is a creation of that spark of Energy. Because man lives in ignorance, man continues to cut a cake on a day that is fake and believes he is the body that was born 9 months after he was actually conceived. As long as we are imprisoned by ignorance, we will always believe that we are the mortal body that will die, not the immortal spark of energy that is the real 'I'.

Let us reflect on what we have traversed in this book till now. The fact that we are born is known. The question that arises is — Where does the person go? In the past, people believed in the fairy tale that people who die will either go to heaven or hell. So do many religions and scriptures tell. However, modern man does not believe this myth. He uses his intellect to question and discriminate the truth. Once

a person dies, then who goes to heaven or hell? Where are these places located? How does one go there? Finally, if the body is destroyed, then, who goes there?

This leads us to the simple truth that the one who was alive and who has just departed or died, has left the body and gone somewhere. Where? If we use inference, just like we infer the existence of the Law of Gravity, we will come to realize the truth. When we throw a ball up in the sky, does it fly away? No! It is pulled back to the centre of the earth. We infer this to be the force of gravity and so accept the Law of Gravity.

This is not a myth or a fairy tale. This is the Natural Law of Cycles. A sunset somewhere is not the end of the sun's journey but results in a sunrise somewhere else. It is for us to realize this truth, to reconcile and join the dots of death and birth and use inference to realize that rebirth is a reality.

Our near and dear ones are so sure that we have left the body and gone, that they cremate or bury the body. Do they ever do that when we are fast asleep in bed? How would they! While we understand that we are alive in the body from birth to death, we don't realize that we are not the body. As we review this point now, is there any doubt that when we burn the dead body of somebody who has passed away, are we committing murder? This is not murder. The person has left the body. The

body has to be destroyed. Otherwise, it would stink. Isn't that proof enough that we are not the body that we inhabited? We don't know where the deceased has gone, but we are sure that the one who departed is not in the body anymore. Doctors even certify this through a death certificate. Why then do we continue to believe that we are this body? Why then do we continue to cut a cake on a birthday, which is fake? Neither is the date right nor is that body us. We are that spark that is immortal. It is never born, and it never dies. At death, it leaves the body and at conception, it arrives as the zygote. We are that spark of energy. Is there any doubt that we are not the body, but this spark of energy? Contemplate birth. The body can be seen to form over 9 months. When we are conceived, we are just a spark in the zygote, that eventually multiplies into two cells and four cells, and in a few weeks, a scan shows the picture of the head forming. Because the mind doesn't exist! Why then does the mind trouble us so much if it has no existence? We create the

It doesn't reveal itself. But it can create so much misery and pain. Today, the world has so many psychiatric doctors who prescribe pills under the category 'mental medicine' or medicine for the mind.

If one goes to investigate what is 'mental medicine', one will realize it is nothing but tranquilizers or sleeping pills or medication that will help us slow down our thoughts. The moment we lose Consciousness, the psychiatric disorder disappears because the mind is at rest. Unfortunately, when we wake up, the rascal appears again to bombard us with thoughts.

In the journey of life, our biggest challenge is to tame the monkey mind that jumps from thought to thought. We have to cut the tail of the monkey mind, the EY that is Ever Yelling and Ever Yearning. The moment we cut the tail, we tame the monkey mind into a monk. The monk is silent and still. There is no fear, worry, or anxiety. However, it is not easy to tame this monkey. Some people try to kill it; they try to destroy it completely by cremating it, or burying it so that there is no sign of its existence. But the mind doesn't let go. That is why, throughout life, we live in ignorance thinking that this is my house, my car, my family, when in reality nothing is ours. When we realize this truth, we are enlightened.

Enlightenment is a process where we overcome all the myth and switch on the light to eliminate the darkness of ignorance in our life. When you enter a room that has no light, you can see nothing. But the moment you switch on the light, you see everything in the room – the table and chairs, the bed and gadgets, and even the light that caused everything to become visible. Enlightenment is also switching on the light. The only difference is that the light of Enlightenment has to be

switched on inside us. Within us, there is a lot of darkness. This darkness creates ignorance and the truth about life gets concealed. When we are enlightened, the light within comes on and we realize the truth of who we are and why we are here.

The fact is that our birthday is not our birthday, but unless there is Enlightenment, we will continue to cut a cake on a day that is fake. When we awake, and stop following the fairy tales, then we are enlightened. Therefore, Enlightenment is about being awakened, realizing that we are not the body that was formed after we were conceived as a zygote. Enlightenment is experiencing the truth that we are that spark that arrives 9 months before our birthday and departs at death. It is the Realization that the spark in you and me is the same energy, just like the electricity in our TV, bulb, and air conditioner comes from the same source. When we are enlightened, we realize that we are that energy, not the gross, physical body or the subtle body consisting of the mind and ego that we appear to be. This is Enlightenment.

When we are not enlightened, we are enveloped by the darkness of ignorance. We follow the myth because we don't realize the truth. Until the light of Enlightenment shines, and in that light, there is Consciousness, that state where the monkey mind is tamed into a monk, we will continue to live as unenlightened beings and we will suffer.

Enlightenment is that state where we are liberated from the triple suffering, from the pain of the body, misery of the mind and agony of the ego because there is the realization that we are none of these. We are the Divine Soul, the Spirit or the *Atman*. Unfortunately, while only 1% of the world is visually blind, 99% of people are spiritually blind. They cannot see the truth. They need Enlightenment.

THE 10 TENETS OF REBIRTH

*What is the truth about the theory of rebirth?
Is it a fact that we return to earth?*



While we do not question birth and accept it as a reality, many of us are not sure whether a birth is just a birth or in fact, it is a rebirth on earth. To realize this truth, we need to contemplate death. Is death an illusion or is it a fact that every body must die? We don't doubt this. Death is certain. Once a person dies, we say that person has passed away. We have no doubt that the person who is dead is no more the body that lies on the bed. We are so sure, that we cremate or bury the body, which we would dare not do if one were just asleep. Therefore, we are sure that the person who was alive has left the body. But where have they gone? Is it true that there is a distant heaven or hell and if there is, who will go there and how? This seems to be a fairy tale. However, there is no doubt that we are rewarded for our deeds in a heaven or punished for our sins in a hell, right here on earth when we return in a rebirth. That is the reason one child is born blind and another in very kind circumstances. This is not because the newborn baby has some luck or fortune or some very special blessing from God.

This is because of the simple Law of Karma, the law of action and reaction.

When we die, our body dies, but ME, the Mind and Ego, carries its Karma and returns in a new birth. This becomes obvious when we join the dots of death, our departure, our unsettled Karma, and our birth. Only an enlightened person can understand the 10 tenets of rebirth and realize the truth. Not everybody can. Contemplate these carefully:

1. Death is certain - Every 'body' has to die
2. Only the body dies. The one alive, the Mind and Ego, ME departs, passes away, and moves on.
3. We are so sure of the deceased departing that we cremate or bury the body.
4. The ME, Mind and Ego leaves the body carrying its Karma, but where does it go?
5. Does ME, the Mind and Ego go to a heaven or hell? Yes, but not far away in the skies, rather, right here on earth.
6. That is why one child is born blind, which is hell, and another child in very kind circumstances, which is heaven.
7. The fortune of a child is not based on any luck or will of God, but on Karma.
8. To settle all pending Karmas, at the death of the body, the Mind and Ego, ME has to return in a rebirth.
9. As long as we believe we are ME, Mind and Ego, we will create Karma and come back to earth in a rebirth.
10. If we overcome ignorance, and realize we are not ME, Mind and Ego, we are the Divine SOUL - Spark Of Unique Life, then, there is no Karma, there is no rebirth. We are united with SIP, the Supreme Immortal Power.

When we contemplate our birth and death, not only do we realize when we were born but also who we truly are. This Realization can ultimately lead to liberation from rebirth.

ESCAPE FROM REBIRTH

*Is it a must that we must be reborn on earth?
Or is there a way we can escape from rebirth?*



Many people believe that rebirth is a cycle in which we will be reborn, and this will go on and on. There is no escape! But the truth is, we can be free, and this is possible if we realize we are not the Mind and Ego, ME.

As we contemplate the truth of our birthday, and realize that not only is the date fake, but we are not the body that develops over 9 months, we can also be enlightened about the truth that the Mind and Ego, ME is a myth. It does not exist. While the mind seems to be present, in reality, where is the mind, we cannot find! It is not a gross physical entity that can be identified or seen. It is just a bundle of thoughts that appears as the mind. When there are no thoughts, there is no mind.

This leads us to the realization that we are that spark of energy that comes alive at conception 9 months before our birthday. Our birth happens because there is pending Karma. The pending Karma was carried by the illusory Mind and Ego, ME which came into existence because of our ignorance. However, the moment we realize that we are neither the body that dies, nor the mind we cannot find, nor the ego that says 'I', then we realize that we are none other than the Divine Spirit, the Soul or *Atman*.

The realization that we are the SOUL - Spark Of Unique Life, not the body, mind and ego, liberates us from our ignorance about who we are. cut a cake. It is time to awake. It is time to make some resolutions that will take you forward on the Spiritual path. It is not only about cutting the cake but also shaking away all the myths that you have lived with. You question every ritual, every superstition you have been following. You resolve to go on a quest and not stop till you realize the truth.

The moment you realize that you were conceived 9 months before, you also realize that you are not the body. When the body pains, you don't suffer. Just like when a car has an accident, it is the car that is damaged, not you. You start realizing that you are not the body but you are the one who wears the body. All this leads you to that ultimate realization that you are the Divine Soul. You treat everybody with oneness, with non-duality, because you realize we are all part of SIP, the Supreme Immortal Power.

What does it mean to be still like a lake? This is key to being enlightened with the truth. It means being thoughtless. This state of thoughtlessness is referred to as Consciousness. It is being like a still lake, with no ripples or waves. How is this possible?

We have spoken about how we must tame the monkey mind and make it into a monk, how we must watch it, catch it and latch it. In fact, we have to kill it! What does it mean to kill the mind? It is so ironic and funny, but we don't change our habit. Although our name is John, we prefer to say, 'I am John', though I am not John and I had no name when I was born!

The moment we realize the truth, we will stop all these meaningless rituals. There are hundreds of such rituals that we perform, knowingly and unknowingly. Somehow, we continue as if it is beyond our control. Because we do so, we continue to sink in ignorance. We must have the courage to stop. We must question every lie that we are taught. We must break free from rituals and rather, spend time in contemplation of the truth.

If we truly love our parents and grandparents, we must do everything possible for them when they are alive and not bow down our head after they are dead. When will we be able to discriminate between black, white, blue, and red?

DO PRAYERS ACTUALLY WORK?

*Those who believe that whatever in prayer you ask, you will receive,
They go a temple or a church with innocence...
But without Enlightenment, themselves they deceive.*



People don't know the meaning of prayer. They think prayer is a scheme to move God. It is like putting a coin in a slot machine. You press the button and what you ask comes out. I grew up believing that prayers are answered in 4 ways.

*When the idea is not right, God says 'No!'
When the time is not right, God says 'Slow!'
When we are not ready, God says 'Grow!'
But when everything is right, then God says, 'Go!'*

What does this mean? It means that whatever we ask in prayer will not necessarily happen. The Supreme Immortal Power, SIP, whom you may refer to as God, understands what is good and bad for us. Further, SIP has created Universal Laws by which our life is governed. So, if we plant apples, and we pray that we should get mangoes, will we? Just like the fruit on the tree depends on the seed, everything that happens in our life depends on our deed. It may be past

deeds or present. It is twin Karma, a combination of both, past and present actions that will control our destiny. So then, what is the role of prayer?

Are prayers meaningless? Do prayers not work? Of course, prayers work. But it all depends, whether we understand the true meaning of prayer or not. Who is God, and what do we say when we pray? If we don't know to whom we pray and we don't understand what we say when we pray, then how can prayers work?

The truth is that the kingdom of God is within. God lives in the temple of our heart. When we realize this, we also realize that God is everywhere, in everything. When we live treating everybody as God, is there any doubt that every prayer will work? This is called God-Realization. It comes from Self-Realization, and it all starts when we realize our birthday is fake. We then realize that we are that spark that started 9 months earlier, that very spark departs at death, that spark is SIP, part of the Supreme Immortal Power. When we realize the truth that we come with nothing and go with nothing, when we realize we are the Divine Soul, then our prayers will become more relevant. We will not make frivolous prayers.

When we are forced to pray because our problems are bigger than what we can handle, prayers make us stronger. This is the first type of prayer. The second type of prayer is asking God for something. These prayers generally don't work because Karma is in charge. What we give is what we get. The third type of prayer is that of a seeker, seeking Enlightenment. Here, the Divine intervenes and helps us on the path, sometimes directly and sometimes through the hand of a Guru. The fourth type of prayer is the prayer of the enlightened one, the realized one who realizes that God or SIP is everywhere, in everything. He lives a life of a Yogi, ever-united with the Divine.

OVERCOME IGNORANCE

*Either we can choose to believe the myth and live in a trance...
Or Ask, Investigate and Realize the Truth, and wipe out ignorance.*



We have a choice. Either we can accept our ignorance and find a way out of it or be ignorant of our ignorance and live and die with it. The facts are right in front of us. Our birthday is not our birthday. But if we continue to celebrate it, even God cannot help us. The fact is that we are not this body, we are that spark of energy that was conceived as the zygote. Nobody can deny this. It is a fact! But if we don't accept it, this is ignorance. We all believe that one day, we will die. This is our ignorance. We know people will burn or bury our body because we depart; we leave the body and people are sure we passed away. Still, throughout life, we keep on saying 'I' and 'me', although this is not our real identity. If this is not ignorance, then what is it? Although our body returns to dust, we still believe that we will go to heaven or hell, somewhere up in the skies. Our ignorance makes us believe that we will go up there and meet our ancestors and those who have departed before us. How can we be so foolish when we know for sure that those who are dead are completely shredded to

pieces! There is no question of a dead person reappearing in the gross physical form. The only possibility is that they return in a rebirth on earth.

How can we overcome this ignorance? The first step is to acknowledge our ignorance and the second, to find out what the truth is. Unless a doctor diagnoses the problem, he cannot prescribe medicine. So also, we must list all the myths that we have lived with, put down all that seems foolish and one by one, overcome it. Ignorance is considered to be like darkness. You can't take a broom and sweep it out of the room. You need to switch on a light. Then you will see everything. We need to switch on the light within, to be enlightened, to overcome the darkness of ignorance by Realization of the truth.

A man once started screaming, 'Save me! Save me!', as he knocked on the door of the house in the dark. His wife quickly opened the door and asked, 'What happened?' He replied, 'There is a snake just beside the door! Let us run away fast.' The wife was an intelligent woman. She immediately put the torch light where the snake was supposed to be, but there was no snake! It was just a rope. The man's fear disappeared, but not his ignorance. He went closer, even touched the rope with apprehension and accepted that there was no snake. But he asked the question, 'Where did the snake go?' The wife tried to explain that there was no snake. It was just a rope which he mistook to be a snake. But he refused to accept this.

Some of us can be wise. We can use our intellect to discriminate and to overcome ignorance. But some of us can ignore this tool of discrimination and live like a fool, letting our ignorance make us suffer!

THE IMPORTANCE OF A SPIRITUAL MASTER, A GURU

*A true Guru takes us from Gu to Ru, from darkness to light.
He helps us overcome ignorance and makes our inner world bright.*



What is the way out of ignorance? What is the way to realize the truth? What is the way to Enlightenment? Enlightenment is not knowledge. You may read this book, and you may acquire a lot of knowledge but remain in a pile of ignorance. How can you eliminate ignorance? How can knowledge become realization?

When we put water in a refrigerator, it remains water until the temperature dips. When it will crystalize into ice, it is no more water. So also, knowledge will remain knowledge till we realize the truth. Then, the knowledge becomes Enlightenment. Who can help us to move from knowledge to Realization? Only an enlightened Master, a Spiritual mentor or Guru can do so. However, he must be a genuine realized Soul, not one who appears to be religious or Spiritual through his robes or personal demeanour. The glow of an enlightened Soul can be seen from his wisdom, his humility and the way he lives in this world.

Unless we find a Guru, a Spiritual Master, we will just go around in circles. The Guru himself is enlightened and knows the tricks played by the mind. He has himself dealt with the illusory ME, Mind and Ego. Not only does he know that he is not the body, mind, and ego, he has realized this truth. He lives as the Divine Soul, with only one goal, to be liberated and then ultimately, be united with the Divine.

A true Guru will never be religious. He has evolved from the kindergarten of religion and passed through the university of spirituality. He doesn't pray to a God, but rather *through* the God that was his *Ishta Deva* – personal God. The Guru realizes that God is SIP, the Supreme Immortal Power that is omnipresent - present everywhere, omniscient - knows everything and omnipotent - capable of any miracle. We need a Guru to handhold us through the journey of Enlightenment. Otherwise, we will continue to be ignorant and do things like cutting a cake on a day that is fake. Even if we know it is fake, we will not awake. A Spiritual Mentor plays a key role in the Enlightenment journey, which is incomplete without the guidance of a Guru and the Grace of God.

As we live in this world today, there is so much noise. There are hundreds of religions, dozens of philosophies, and theologies of so many masters, authors, and speakers. What is the truth and what is the myth? How will we discriminate? The only way is to use our intellect. Then what is the role of the Guru? The Guru helps us to sharpen our intellect so that we can cut through thoughts that are not true and that cause us to believe in fairy tales. The Guru trains us on a path that will help us move onward, forward, inward, upward, and Godward. Without the help of a Guru, it will be very difficult, practically impossible to climb the arduous peak of Enlightenment.

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF HUMAN BIRTH ON EARTH?

*Have you ever pondered why you got this human birth?
It is time to stop and realize what is our purpose on earth.*



Only human beings are blessed with an intellect that can discriminate. No other living creature can. Why? Because only a human being is capable of Enlightenment. A dog cannot go through the process of Purification. A frog cannot go through the process of Illumination. A butterfly, a bee or a tree cannot experience Self-Realization. Only a human being is capable of using his intellect if he wishes to and get liberation from ignorance, from the misery on earth, and from rebirth. Only a human being can attain that state of Unification with the Divine. However, if we do not discover what is our purpose on earth, then, we will just waste this birth. We will live and we will die and then, we will be reborn, and this will go on and on.

I enjoyed the celebrations and made many resolutions each year. I climbed from peak to peak, till one day, my Spiritual Master, J. P. Vaswani, Dada, as we fondly called him, asked me the question, 'Are you just going to live like this till you die or are you going to go on a *Talaash*, a quest and find out who am I?' This was after I had travelled across the world for more than 5 years, and visited over 100 countries, across the 7 continents. I had previously worked for 25 years, creating a successful business and making enough money. After that journey of achievement, and a siesta of fulfilment, my Guru provoked me to start my journey of Enlightenment.

In that quest, my *Talaash*, I spent years getting to the Realization of the truth. First, I realized what I am not. I am not this body. It will return to dust. Immediately, I transformed my life and changed my name to

Finally, came that moment of 'Aha!', the ultimate Realization when pieces of the Spiritual Jigsaw puzzle fell into place. 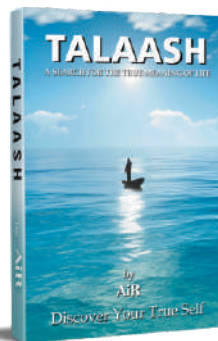

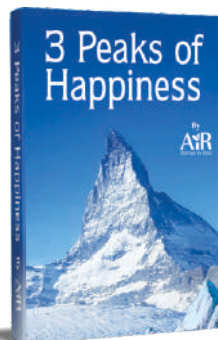
1. Talaash

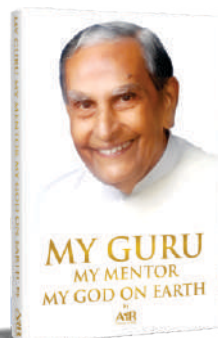
2. 3 Peaks of Happiness
