BEING RELIGIOUS IS NOT SPIRITUALITY

WHAT IS RELIGION?

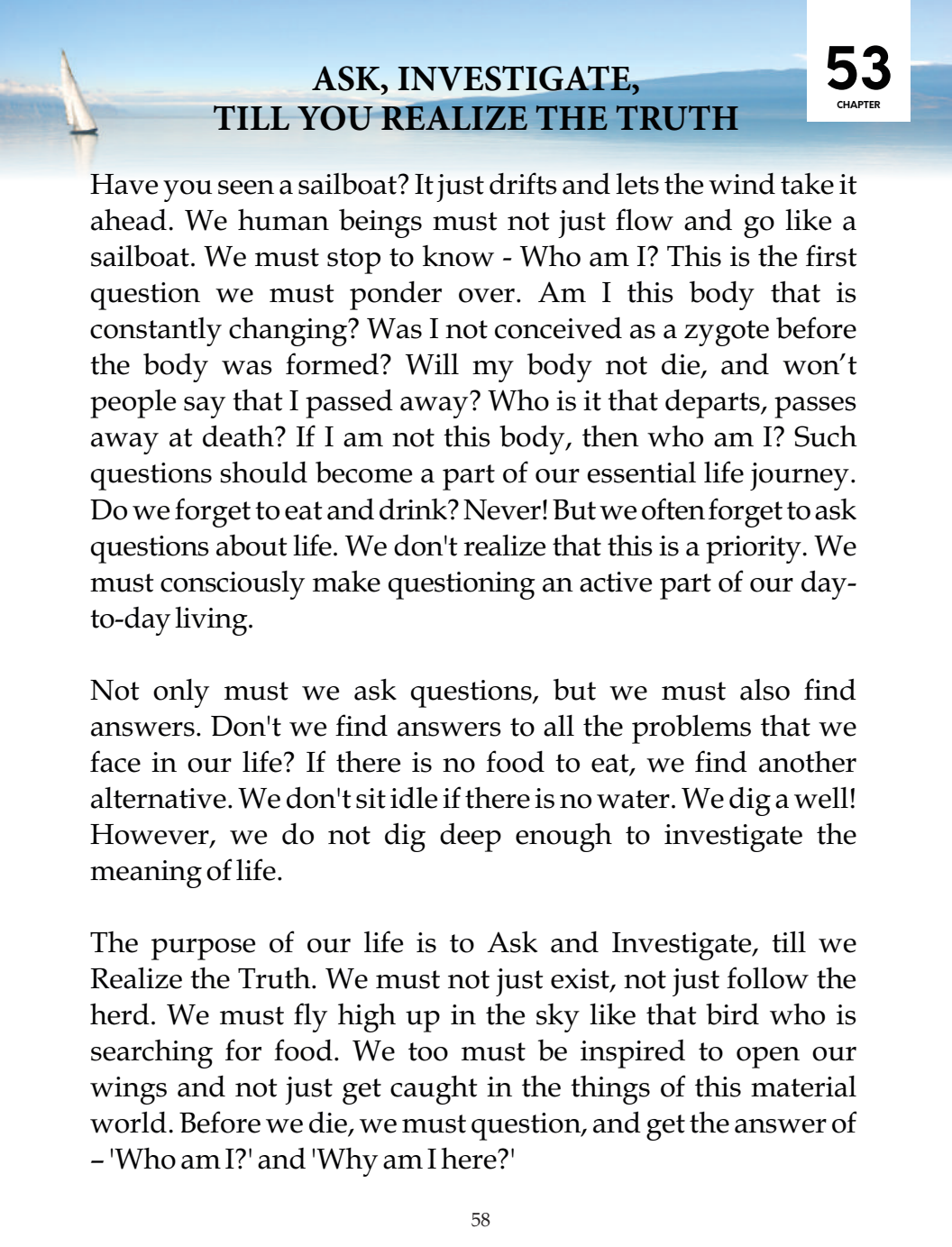


WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF OUR LIFE ON EARTH?

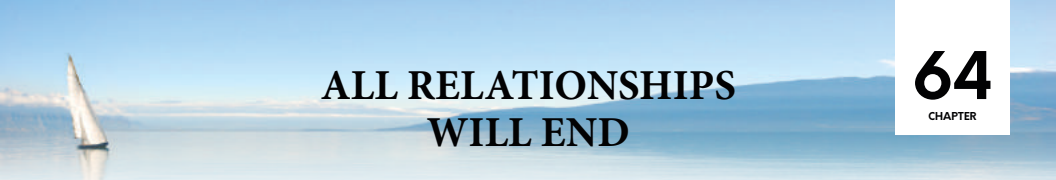


WE CAN TAKE NOTHING WITH US



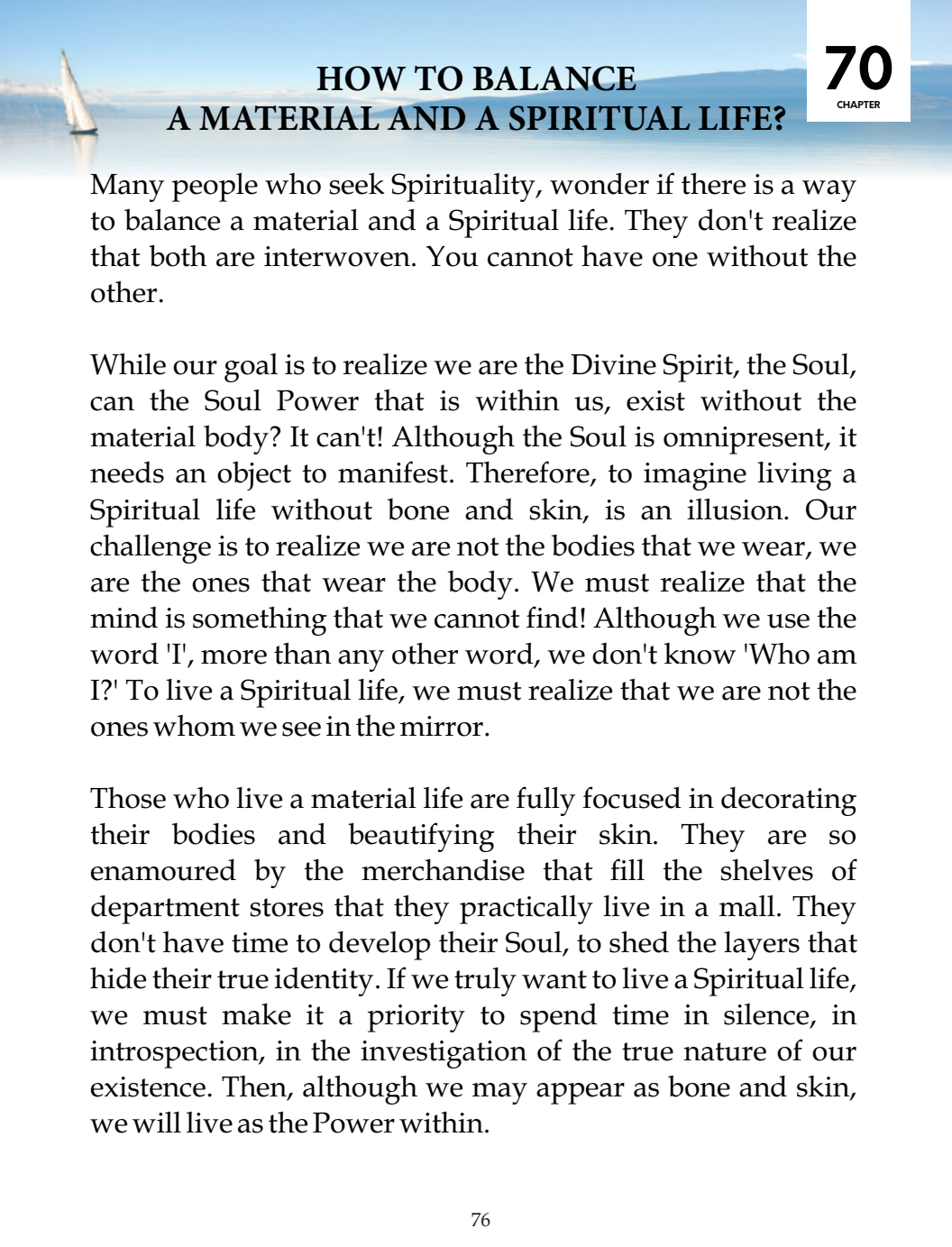


YOU CANNOT LIVE A SPIRITUAL LIFE ANYWHERE ELSE

LIVING WITH CONSCIOUSNESS

Spirituality is transcending the ego that appears along with the mind and says, 'It is me.' When we become Conscious that we are the Divine Soul, then we transcend the senses of the body and the mind and ego, ME. This is true Spirituality.

Knowing all the above is not Consciousness. We need Realization. When knowledge crystallizes into Realization, then there is Consciousness. Consciousness is awareness. We no more have to memorize it because we realize it. Those who live a Spiritual life, let go of the desires of the senses, and the wandering of the mind because they live in the Consciousness of the Truth, in *Ananda* or bliss. Those who do not live a Spiritual life, won't even understand the meaning of Consciousness, because they have never experienced it.

The key to living a Spiritual life is being free from misery. Only one who is Spiritually awakened can escape from the suffering caused by physical pain, the misery caused by the mind, and the agony caused by the ego. Normal human beings cannot escape from this suffering. Only those who are living a Spiritual life are liberated from the triple suffering on earth.

How does somebody living a Spiritual life get freedom from the sorrows of the body, mind and ego? With the Realization that I am the Divine Soul, not the body and mind that I appear to be, one is instantly free from the triple suffering. Does it mean that the body will not experience physical pain? Of course, it will. But he who is living a Spiritual life will not be pained by the aches of the body. It is like one having a car accident. Although the car is smashed, the one inside is untouched and unaffected by the crash. So does a Spiritual Soul live in a body that undergoes physical trauma but does not relate to the pain as his suffering.

Just as a realized Soul is free from suffering caused by physical pain, his mind tries to worry and wander in fear. However, he is not the mind, and he does not join the mind in its tragic thoughts. He lives as the Soul in consciousness, observing the mind. Hitherto, one would be agonized by anger, hate, revenge, and jealousy. Now, realizing that we are all the same Divine Soul, the oneness created liberates one from all such anguish.

Those of us who are trapped in the material world, live in *Bhoga*. We are attached to our possessions and our people. We are not free from desires and cravings, that make us live as common mortals. But the moment we start living a Spiritual life, we shift from *Bhoga*, being connected to the material world to living in Yoga. The word Yoga means *Yuj* or union. The Divine Spirit in us, lives in Yoga, with the Supreme Spirit that is omnipresent. One who lives in Yoga, lives as a blissful Yogi, ever united with God.

What is it to live like a Yogi? A Yogi is fearless. He overcomes the fear of death and disease. He realizes the Truth that his body is just like a garment that he, the Divine Soul, wears. He is no more interested in the material desires that enamoured him in the past. He lets go of all these illusions, realizing that nothing really belongs to us. We come from the Divine and return to the Divine. The Yogi attains freedom from the material world and is liberated from the lust of wishes, wealth and wine. He lives as a manifestation of the Divine, experiencing the Lord everywhere and in everything. To him, the kingdom of God is within. He is in constant union as he cuts off the noise of this material world, to hear the voice of the Divine in his Soul within. Such a Yogi lives in the ever Consciousness of the Truth, experiencing a state of eternal happiness and everlasting peace, free from all the miseries of the world. A Yogi lives in the material world but lives as the Divine Spirit.

Those who live a Spiritual life, live in constant Yoga, or union with the Divine. It is not the union of the body with the mind and Soul as advocated by the Yoga institutes that have mushroomed all over the world today. All over the world, people portray Yoga to be *Asanas*, physical exercises or *Pranayama*, breathing techniques. These are just preliminary stages of Yoga, and they may or may not lead one to live like a Yogi.

What is it to experience real Yoga? A Yogi experiences the 4 cycles of Yoga. He starts his day with *Dhyana* Yoga or meditation, then spends some time in *Bhakti* Yoga or prayer and devotion. Thereafter, he does *Karma* Yoga, performing his Spiritual duties as per the Divine Will as an instrument of God, without expecting any result or fruits of the actions performed. Finally, in all the time left, the Yogi lives in *Gyana* Yoga. In this state, he is united with the Lord as he spends his time in attaining wisdom, in reading, in listening, or in discussions about Spirituality.

A Yogi does not get out of the 4 cycles of Yoga. The moment his mind and the senses of his body make him lose his Spiritual Consciousness, he realizes it and returns to the cycles of Yoga, living as the Divine Spirit that he has realized he is. One who lives in constant Yoga is not only free from the triple suffering but is ever united with God. He becomes a part of that Supreme Spirit, with the Realization that he is not the body or mind. He is the Divine Soul.



THE BLISS OF *SATCHITANANDA*

Everybody wants to be happy. The whole world is in quest of bliss and peace. However, we don't realize that happiness is like a shadow. The more you chase it, the further it goes away. We are taught that success is happiness. We spend our entire life trying to find happiness through achievement, money and wealth, name and fame. Not only is there silence in his ears, because he is free from the pandemonium of this world, a Spiritual Soul also experiences the stillness of thought. This develops into the Power of super Consciousness. One who lives a Spiritual life, shuts off the noise outside so that he can hear the Divine voice inside. 
HAPPINESS IN A SPIRITUAL WORLD

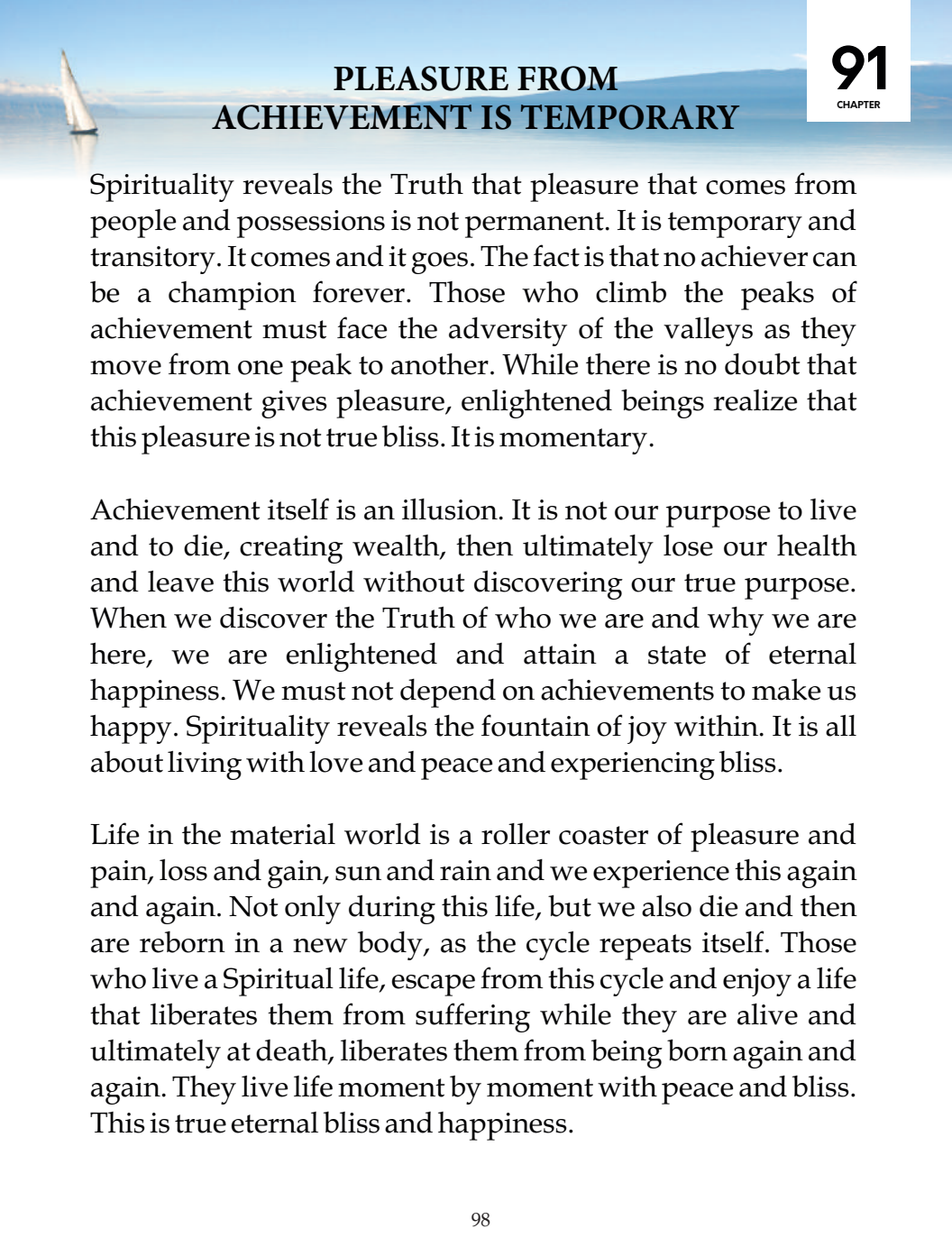
THE THREE PEAKS OF HAPPINESS

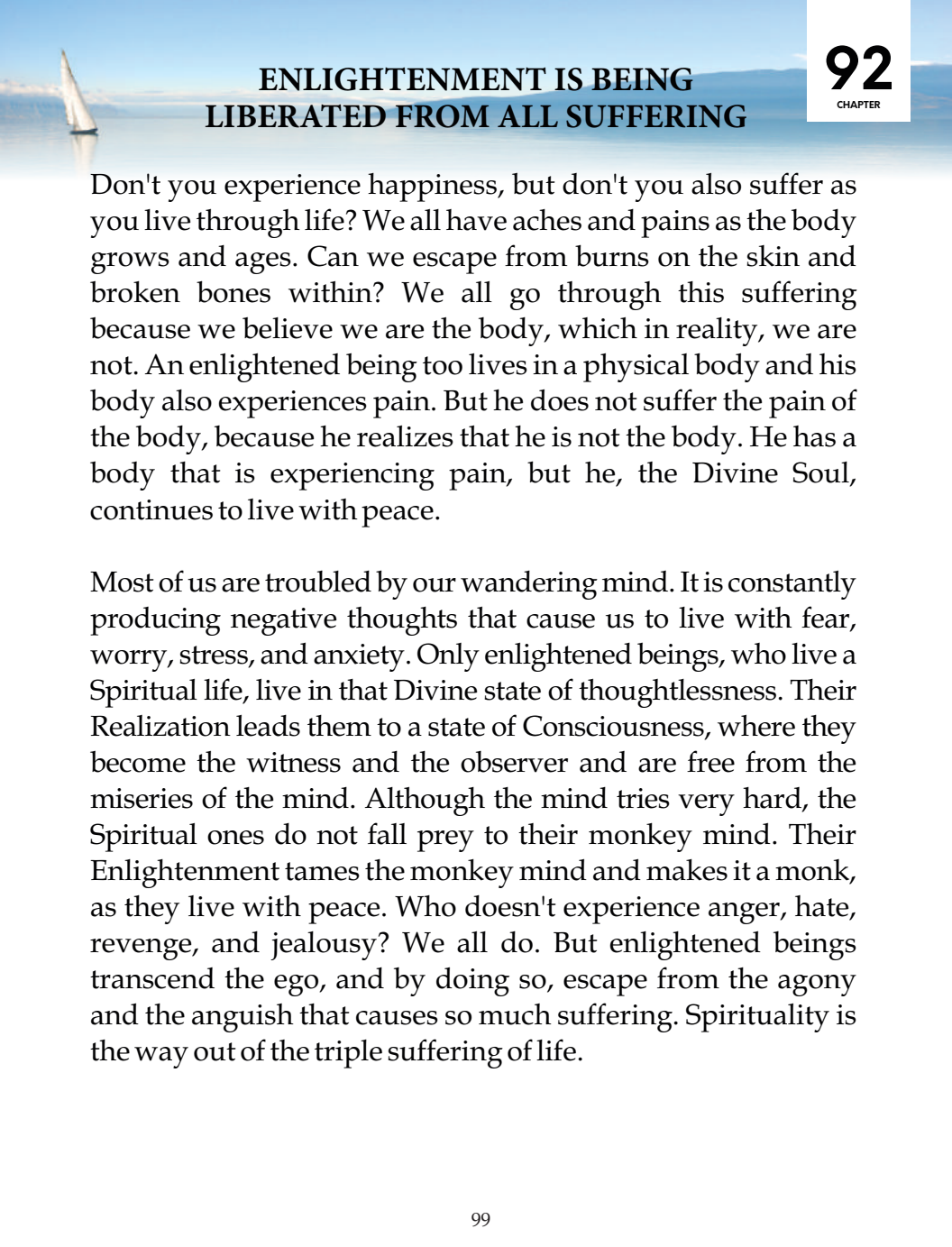
PLEASURE FROM ACHIEVEMENT IS TEMPORARY

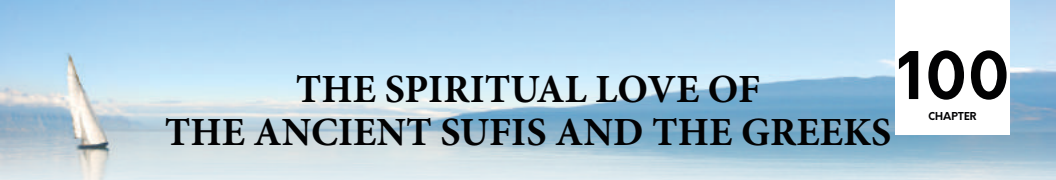
SPIRITUAL LOVE FLOWS TO THE DIVINE IN ALL






YOU CAN CONTINUE TO LIVE IN THE MATERIAL WORLD
