We human beings have been given a free will, a power to choose. We have been blessed with an intellect that discriminates thoughts. An elderly carpenter was ready to retire. He had built many houses for his boss. His boss requested him to build one last house. The carpenter resorted to shoddy workmanship and used inferior materials. When his boss came to inspect the house, he handed the key to the carpenter, 'This is your house,' he said, 'my gift to you.'

Therefore, everything that happens in life, happens because of our Karma. While Karma by itself means action, the term Karma denotes the Law which nobody can circumvent. Based on the principle – As you sow, so shall you reap, this Law makes no mistake. Just like it is in any game, our Karma seems to earn us a positive and negative score, which then has to be settled. ### WHAT IS THE CONNECTION BETWEEN KARMA AND LIFE?



Life is Karma. Unfortunately, if the human race understood this truth, they would live with grace. Today, we live with greed, and we don't just work to fulfil our need but we have desires and passions that make us crave till we reach our grave. The Ego thinks – 'I am responsible for my life. I can make the impossible possible.' What we don't realize is that every action of ours controls our life. We might have performed some actions in the distant past, even in a previous life, but they will not leave us. They will unfold as circumstances in our life and create challenges, even problems that will stop us from our dreams.

Therefore, he continued to ignore his actions and his life became more and more complicated.

Shyam believed in the Law of Karma. He invested his deeds to become seeds that unfolded in the destiny of his dreams. Even if something unpleasant happened, Shyam realized that it must have been his past Karma. He never reacted to it negatively. Instead, he accepted it gracefully and moved forward doing good Karma.

Just like Shyam and Raju, we all experience life with what seems like good luck and bad luck. We don't realize that there is nothing like luck. It is our own actions that control our life.

While we know we are in command of our deeds, we don't realize that our life itself is unfolding as per our Karma, our past actions. If only we realized that we were the masters of our life, we would control every action, so that we could control every aspect, every circumstance of life that is unfolding.

Unfortunately, we don't realize that we cannot control circumstances. While we can control actions, we cannot control past actions. Thus he lost control of his life. Instead of realizing that our life depends on our own actions, our own Karma, he wasted his life believing in these mysteries. He would spend hours gazing at a crystal ball, trying to see his future in it, rather than waking up and walking ahead to make his dreams come true. How can we look at a crystal ball and discover our future? How can a parrot pick up a card from a pack of printed destinies to reveal our future? Raj continued to lament about his bad luck as years passed, surrendering to fortune-tellers. He lived his life believing in horoscopes, rather than in Karma. One day he died.

Should we live like Raj and let our life be controlled by myths and superstitions? Should we not realize the science behind the Law of Karma? Is it difficult to understand that it is action that controls reaction, nothing else? This entire universe is unfolding moment by moment, not by chance, but by choice of our actions. Everything that happens in this life is like a boomerang. Don't we see that what goes around comes around? ### DO THOUGHTS CREATE KARMA?



Many people wonder about evil thoughts becoming sins. There is no doubt that thoughts are very powerful. Thoughts create feelings and feelings can become actions. But thoughts by themselves do not create bad Karma. They are not capable of interfering with the Karmic Law.

While many in the world believe that bad thoughts are equal to bad Karma, let us understand the simple logic. We get thousands of thoughts every day. Thoughts are beyond our control. If we permit these thoughts to become actions, they become Karma, both good and bad. However, we have been given the gift of intellect. The intellect is that domain which discriminates thoughts. It is that aspect of our life that permits us to choose what to do and what not to do. It is only a human being that has been given this free will, this choice and intellect. If we do not use this gift and we become a slave of our mind, then we are sure to let our evil thoughts become bad deeds which will plant the seeds to a miserable destiny.

Kamala had a crooked mind. She would not only become jealous about her friend's success, but she would take revenge at the slightest opportunity to get even. Her mind motivated her to do these evil deeds and Kamala suffered. Every evil deed, every sin, became a Karma that was recorded in her Karmic account. The Law of Karma makes no mistake. She had to pay back for every bad deed. Everybody could see Kamala suffer. But Shamala, her friend, had learned the art of not letting her evil thoughts become sins. Whenever a bad thought appeared, she would shoot it down with her intellect. Because there were no bad actions in Shamala's life, there was no bad Karma recorded. She lived a happy and peaceful life.

While Kamala and Shamala reveal how a bad thought in itself is not bad Karma, if we still doubt it, we can ask ourselves the simple question — If we have the most wonderful thoughts of helping others, being kind and compassionate, but do nothing about it, will these thoughts result in our destiny? A beggar used to trouble an old woman every day requesting for a chapati. The old lady had a son who had gone to war and had disappeared and she was very anxious and irritated. The beggar kept on asking for a chapati every day. One day, being frustrated she thought of putting poison in the chapati and ending this. Somehow her conscience inside stopped her from putting the poison. She did not want to kill the beggar. After a few days, her son came back. He told her that he was on his way home when he was hit and badly injured. A poor beggar had taken care of him and had given him a chapati every day. The woman found out later that it was the same beggar whom she was planning to kill.

The Law of Karma is very clear. It is deeds, not thoughts! Just like people who talk, but who don't walk, achieve nothing, so also thoughts are of little use. Surely, thoughts influence action, but by themselves, thoughts do not create any Karma. We must pay a lot of attention to our actions. Thoughts are thoughts. They will appear. But just as they appear, we can use our intellect to make them disappear. Every thought does not become an action. Those who realize this, take charge of their thoughts, control their actions, and take charge of their destiny. They do not let their mind become their master. And so, they do good Karma and to their destiny, they reach faster.

But once he does, he is responsible for his actions.

This is the reason that only human beings create Karma. Animals, trees, birds or fish do not create Karma. While many Eastern philosophies believe that all these living creatures are experiencing their past Karma, one thing is sure, they are not creating any new Karma. Maybe a cockroach or a lizard is paying for its sins. But animals and other creatures do not have an intellect, a free will to choose their actions. Only man is blessed to choose his actions.

While man is blessed to do what he wants to do, he is also blessed to create Karma of his choice. It is a blessing no doubt because it is through these Karma that man can create a destiny of his dreams. It is through the choice of his actions that man can execute good deeds and stay away from wrong doings. Unfortunately, we don't realize this. Just like the Law of Cycles makes the earth rotate, day after day causing day and night, the Law of Action and Reaction too unfolds birth after birth. Nobody can escape from it. Therefore, our ultimate goal is not to create a destiny in this physical world but to understand Karma and transcend it. When we go beyond Karma, then, we can attain the ultimate destiny that man must achieve. It is known as *Nirvana* or *Moksha*, Enlightenment or Salvation. It is Liberation from this world and Unification with the Divine. How can we arrive at this destiny? How can we become one with our Lord? It is by being liberated from all Karma, not by just doing good Karma.

If we change the seeds we plant, we can change the fruit on the tree... So also by changing our deeds, we can change our destiny.



#### HOW IS KARMA SETTLED?

Karma is the Law of Action and Reaction. It is very simple. If there is an action, there will be a reaction! The reaction may happen immediately or in the near future. It may also happen many years later when we have forgotten about our action! Or it can happen in our next life when it is impossible for us to relate to what action is this reaction happening for. For one to understand this, one must realize that Karma has 3 accounts. The First Account is a corpus, a carried forward account that continues even after our death, life after life. It is from this account that our birth happens. We bring some Karma from our corpus or warehouse and we start to live. Whatever is happening, is happening because of this Karma we bring to the earth. This is the Second Account. Then, we create new Karma. We perform several actions in this life, and these actions are recorded and merged with what we brought to earth. This is the Third Account.

Based on both our present actions and what we started with, our life unfolds. Everything that is happening in our life is Karma. Unfortunately, we only know the present Karma, the actions that we have performed in this life, but we don't know our past Karma. What is unfolding may not seem fair to us, but we do not realize that Karma is settling our old dues.

We can't escape from Karma. Whatever actions we do, will continue to be recorded in the book of Karma. Whatever is happening in our life, is nothing but Karma. One day, we will die. But only the body dies. Don't people say that we passed away? The one who was directing actions, ME, the mind and ego, carries its Karma and is reborn in a new body. Why does

this happen? This is the only way for our Karma to be settled. Some people believe we go to a distant heaven or hell, but how is this possible? When the body dies and returns to dust, who will go to heaven or hell? We need a body to suffer or to be rewarded and the only way to get a body is to return to earth. To settle Karma, the Law causes our rebirth in such a manner that it matches our past actions. A birth on earth is not luck. Some newborns are fortunate, some unfortunate. What does this depend on? Karma! Karma is settled not only as we live on earth, but also as we take rebirth. If only man ponders on this Truth, he will realize that God has created life, death, and rebirth for the continuation of this world, this Samsaar.

Remember, all your actions will be settled. If they are not settled in this life on earth, know beyond doubt that they will be settled in a rebirth. We cannot escape from Karma. Every action is recorded and redeemed. Good or bad, every deed will be settled. If not in this lifetime, it may be in the next or the one after. This cycle of life, death, and rebirth will go on and on. Therefore, what is the way to escape from death, rebirth, and all the suffering on earth? How to be liberated from all Karma? Is there a way to do it? Yes, if we are enlightened, we can transcend all Karma and be united with God. If only we realize that we are not the body that does Karma, we are not even the ME, the Mind and Ego that is reborn with its Karma, we are the Divine Soul - then we will be free from all Karma.

#### WILL WE BE BORN AGAIN AND AGAIN?



The mystery of rebirth confuses most of humanity. Even scientists with brilliant brains have been unable to decode the mystery. But those who understand the Law of Karma, know beyond doubt that we will be born again and again. Till we are liberated from the cycle of death and rebirth, till we attain our ultimate goal of realizing we are the Divine Soul, we will continue to be born again and again.

Does anybody deny birth? We all know how we were born. Will anybody refuse to accept the reality of death? Death is certain. Every 'body' will die. But while we understand the Truth about birth and death, we don't join the dots to realize that we will be born again and again.

The Law of Karma is such that we cannot escape from rebirth. We have to come back to earth to settle our Karma. When we die, death is abrupt and sudden, and we don't settle all Karma. Therefore, our deeds, good and bad, need to be redeemed. How will we settle our Karma once we are dead? Those who Realize the Truth understand that only the body dies. The one who was alive departs. Don't we say, 'He passed away'? In fact, we are so sure that the one who died passed away leaving the body behind, that we cremate the body. Would we burn somebody who was sleeping in their bed? Never! Unless the doctor pronounces somebody dead, we will not burn the body. But once we depart from the body, the body is destroyed. Where do we go and what about our Karma that is not settled?

Those who probe the Law of Karma, clearly see that the one

who has departed along with their Karma returns to earth in a new body, either to suffer for their sins or to be rewarded for their good deeds. Birth is not a matter of luck. Somebody is born blind and somebody else in circumstances that are very kind. This is because of Karma.

Those who think that we are the body, must ponder on the fact that the body is created much later. Nine months before our 'birthday', our ME, the Mind and Ego, along with our unsettled Karma, is already conceived in the womb as a zygote. What causes this conception? Is it luck? Nothing in this world happens by luck. Everything happens as per an organized plan and as per Divine Universal Laws. When we join the dots together, and we understand birth and its circumstances, death, and unsettled Karma, then we realize that rebirth is a reality. We will be born again and again.

Unfortunately, anybody who is born on earth suffers physical pain of the body, misery of the mind, and agony of the ego. To escape from this triple suffering on this earth and to escape from the constant cycle of rebirth, is the ultimate goal of a human being. How can we escape from rebirth? It is through Enlightenment, through Realization that we are not the body, mind and ego. We are the Divine Soul. Once we realize this, we are free from the cycle of rebirth.

Karma is the way that the Creator makes this world go on and on. Because we have to settle our pending Karma, we are reborn.



### CAN WE ESCAPE FROM REBIRTH?



While this world is an amazing place and most of us are grateful for life, there is one Divine Truth that we cannot escape from. This world is full of suffering. Buddha, the Enlightened One, made this Realization when he renounced his palace, his family and went in quest of the Truth. His quest was based on the fact that this world is *Dukkha*, or suffering. Ultimately, everybody in this world suffers physical pain of the body. We all experience misery in our mind, just as we are anguished with anger, hate, revenge, and jealousy caused by the ego. Therefore, the Enlightened One, the Buddha as he came to be known, prescribed Nirvana to be the ultimate goal of life. 5000 years ago, Sanatana Dharma, the ancient Hindu faith called it Moksha. The Western world calls it Enlightenment, Liberation, and Salvation. In essence, most religions advocate that the ultimate goal of man is to become one with God. For this, we have to escape from taking birth on earth. How can we escape from rebirth?

There is a way to escape from this constant cycle of death and rebirth. Rebirth is caused because we carry Karma or unsettled deeds. Therefore, if we want to escape from being born again and again, we have to make our Karma zero. It is not possible to make Karma zero as long as we live as the body, mind and ego. If we want to be free from all Karma, it can happen only with the Realization of the Truth that we are not the owners of our Karma. We are not even the doers of action. We are not the body, nor are we the Mind and Ego, ME. When this Realization dawns upon us and we are enlightened that we are the Divine Soul, in that very moment we are liberated from all Karma. Not only are we liberated

from the Karma of this lifetime, but all our carried forward Karma of all previous lives that stands in the account of the Mind and Ego, ME, is wiped out in a flash. This happens because we realize that we are not the body nor are we the Mind and Ego, ME. When this Realization happens, where is the question of carrying Karma and being reborn again? We are free from Karma, and attain that state of *Moksha*, Enlightenment or *Nirvana*.

While it is possible to escape from rebirth, very few people are blessed to be enlightened with the Truth that we are not the body, mind and ego. We are the Divine Soul. Only such realized souls escape from rebirth, once they experience death in the body in which they dwell. Since they have realized that they are not the doer of actions, nor are they the mind and ego that is carrying past Karma, this Realization liberates them from returning to earth in a rebirth. While this is possible, is it easy? It is the most difficult goal for a human being to achieve. We human beings believe that we are the body, mind and ego. We live and die with this ignorance. Unless there is Self-Realization and we realize that we are not this body that is constantly changing and that ultimately dies, nor are we the subtle mind that we cannot find, only then can we transcend the ego that keeps on saying 'I' till we die. When we realize we are nothing, but a manifestation of the Divine, we are a dot of Divine Energy manifesting as a body of 30 trillion cells, it is this Realization that can lead to Liberation from all suffering on earth and can liberate us from rebirth and unite us with God. While we can escape from rebirth, still most of us return to earth because we don't Realize the Truth.

## DOES KARMA CONTROL OUR DEATH?



Death is certain. Everybody must die. But while we all know that human beings are born 280 days after conception, 40 weeks after the zygote is formed, do we know when are we going to die? Who controls death? By now we realize that our birth is not a matter of chance, that Karma controls when we were born and where we were born. Then, we have a free will to choose our Karma or actions. But do we have a free will to choose our death?

Those who think that they can commit suicide, do not realize that this is the biggest mistake we can make in our life. Causing an unnatural death only means that we will have to return and face not just all that suffering that led to suicide, but also, pay an extra price for the bad Karma of committing suicide. Death is in the hands of the Divine. We must not interfere or intervene in the unfolding of life. Life must go on till the Divine decides that we must be gone.

What then decides our death? It is Karma. Now that we know that our birth is the result of our past Karma and we also know that our present Karma unfolds as circumstances in our life, we must realize that the phenomenon of death is planned by the Divine whom we call God. GOD is not just Governor Of Destiny, He is also, Giver Of Death. It is the Divine who, through the Law of Karma, decides and inflicts death upon us.

Every living creature must die. While the mountains and oceans are eternal and they do not have a Soul that arrives at birth and departs at death, we human beings are amongst

those living organisms who live and die. Even dogs and cats, butterflies and bees, birds and trees, must live and die. Each has a different lifespan. For instance, human beings can live up to 100 years, and dogs between 10 to 15 years only. Some trees live for 500 years while some, for 5000 years. The Creator has created a lifespan, after which, a living organism must die. For a mayfly, the Creator has given just 24 hours, but a butterfly has two weeks to live.

We human beings know that we can live up to 100 years. Some even cross a century. On an average, the life expectancy of man is about 75 years. Some may die a little earlier, and some may die a little later. We don't understand how, but the moment of our death is controlled by Karma. In fact, everything is. God has created an automatic universe and thus we infer that He is not controlling the death of 8 billion people. Don't we know that about 4,00,000 people are born every day and about 1,50,000 people die every day? All this is not controlled by a God sitting in heaven. All this is controlled by Karma, the Universal Law of life and birth, of death and rebirth.

Karma is life and Karma also controls our death. Therefore, somebody who is 3 months old may suddenly die, and somebody may be stillborn. Can we explain this? Nobody can explain death. Thus, we surrender to Karma and let our Karma continue till our last breath. Who knows we will die today or tomorrow, or we may live for another 10 years or even 50? Remember! Life and death are in the hands of the Divine, controlled by the Universal Law of Karma.

### WILL WE GO TO HEAVEN OR HELL?



Isn't this question on top of our mind many a time? What will happen after we die? Our life has been a mix of good and bad deeds. We all sin sometimes, living in this material world. We seek answers to these questions – Will we go to a heaven or hell? Does God love me? Will God be kind to me? Will He forgive me for my sins? If I pay a part of my earnings to a temple, or a church, or in charity, will I be forgiven? These are the complimentary questions that haunt us when we contemplate death. However, we don't investigate the Truth about heaven and hell.

Where are heaven and hell? Have you seen a picture of any of the two? Has anybody been there? Has anybody given us a first-hand account of it? Never! There is no place like heaven or hell. These are not physical locations. Of course, we imagine that they exist and for sure our religion advocates that after we die, we will go there. But what does this actually mean?

Once we die, what happens in reality? The body returns to dust. We cremate our dear ones and even immerse their left-over ashes in the river. Thereafter, we imagine that they have gone to heaven. But how could they go? Who would go? Where would they go? Heaven and hell are a fairy tale. They are a figment of man's imagination. Does it mean that we will not go to heaven or hell?

Of course, we will experience heaven and hell, they will be experienced right here on earth. We will experience both heaven and hell when we take rebirth. This is the Truth. Unfortunately, when we are kids and we ask our parents

what will happen after we die, we are mostly taught this story — 'If you do good deeds, you will go to heaven where God will reward you. If you sin, your bad deeds will take you to hell, where you will suffer.' Nobody teaches us that heaven and hell are right here on earth and we will experience them at rebirth!

Those who understand the Law of Karma, realize that heaven and hell are a result of Karma. If your life is experiencing hell now, it only means that your past Karma is unfolding in a manner to redeem your past sins. Suffering doesn't happen randomly. Every outcome of our life is a result of our Karma. Therefore, whatever actions we perform, get recorded in our Karmic account. Ultimately, when we die, our Karma, both our current account and corpus that remain to be redeemed, jointly cause our birth. If there is good Karma, we will be born in a heaven on earth. There will be luxury and love, joy and good fortune. But if our cumulative Karma is negative, and we have sinned either in our present life or our past lives, our negative Karma will cause us to be born in a hell and we will suffer. Therefore, both heaven and hell are experienced right here on earth. We don't 'go there'. They do not exist, except in our imagination. When we transcend Karma, then we escape from rebirth, from heaven and hell on earth, and become one with God

#### WHO IS REBORN?

Some people cannot fathom the concept of rebirth. They wonder how somebody can be reborn. To them, death is the end. It's over! The body returns to dust. We cremate the body or bury it. It has no life. They think that rebirth is another fairy tale.

Those who understand Karma and how the Law operates, Realize the Truth about rebirth. They know beyond doubt that rebirth is a reality. Just as they realize that nobody can escape from Karma, they also realize that we cannot escape from rebirth, until we are enlightened and Realize the Truth of who we are.

As long as we live as the body and mind in this material world, we will create Karma. Nobody can escape from action. Every action, good or bad is recorded as our Karma. Ultimately, one day, we will die. But who dies? Don't we say that the deceased passed away? This is only the body, the mortal remains of the one who is dead. While the dead body lies on the bed, we are sure that the one who was alive has left. That is why we destroy the body.

Who leaves the body at death? The believers of Karma know that Karma is never settled at death. There are always residual Karmas that need to be settled. Death is sudden and it does not happen after we square off our good and bad deeds. Therefore, the pending Karma is carried forward by the one who leaves the body at death.

So, who leaves the body at death? It is ME, the Mind and Ego.

In fact, it is the mind and ego that direct the body to act. Those who do not understand the Law of Karma, sometimes think that it is the body that does the Karma and is rewarded or suffers. The reality is that the body is just an instrument. The mind and ego need a body to face its past Karma and to create new Karma. But Karma does not belong to the body. It belongs to ME, the Mind and Ego.

That is why, when the body dies, the Karma does not dissolve. Further, the same body does not appear in a new birth on earth. The body returns to dust. It is game over for the body. Who is reborn? It is the Mind and Ego, ME who takes birth again and again. Just like we change our clothes, the mind and ego change their body life after life. Death, for the mind and ego, is not the end. It is just a bend. At death, the ME, Mind and Ego, leaves the dead body along with its pending Karma and is conceived in a new body to settle the Karma that remains in its account. This cycle will go on and on, till we are enlightened and liberated from the cycle of rebirth.

It is a myth to believe that the Soul is reborn. The Soul is birthless and deathless. It is Divine Energy. It arrives at conception and departs at death. Therefore, neither the body nor the Soul is reborn. The Mind and Ego, the ME takes rebirth as per its Karma.

The body dies but do we know where the deceased has gone?
The Mind and Ego, ME gets into a new body as it is reborn.



### ULTIMATELY, WHOM DOES KARMA BELONG TO?

To understand the A to Z of Karma, one must be very clear, therefore, as to whom the Karma actually belongs to. The doer of Karma is the body. Does Karma belong to the body? The director of an action is the Mind and Ego, ME. Is it ME who owns the Karma? Some people even believe that Karma belongs to the Soul. They think there are good souls and bad souls, that our Soul will go to heaven or hell based on its Karma. They don't realize that the Soul is a particle of God Energy. It does not do Karma, accumulate Karma or is reborn based on Karma. The Soul is birthless and deathless. It gives power to the one who takes birth and gives breath and life till they are alive on earth. The moment the Soul departs, there is death.

While we are clear about birth and death, and we are now clear that Karma does not belong to the Soul, who does Karma ultimately belong to? It seems like Karma belongs to the body, because Karma is action, and it is the body that is doing an action. But in reality, does Karma belong to the body? Suppose I, the ego, am very upset, very angry and feel like taking revenge on somebody who has wronged me. I send my office boy to my enemy, with some poisoned food. The delivery boy delivers the package and my anger is avenged. Who does the Karma belong to, the delivery boy who delivered the poisoned food, or to me? Not the me, the body that I seem to be, but the ME, the Mind and Ego that directed the sinister action to poison and to kill. Therefore, we must realize beyond doubt, that while Karma is done by the body, it is owned by the mind and the ego. While it appears that Karma belongs to the body, the Truth is that Karma belongs to the Mind and Ego, ME, that directs all actions. Is this the

#### ultimate Truth or is there something beyond?

Those who are in the preliminary study of Karma understand very clearly that the body does not have any Karma. It does Karma for the Mind and Ego, ME, just as it suffers along with ME. The Karma belongs to ME, not to the body. Those who go into an in-depth study, also realize that Karma does not belong to the Soul. They are enlightened with this realization. As long as we live with ignorance, we create Karma through the body and the Karma belongs to the Mind and Ego, ME and we suffer again and again for our Karma. Of course, we will also be rewarded for our good deeds. But every time we take birth on earth, we will experience the triple suffering of the body, mind and ego. Even though we may do good Karma, there is no way of escaping suffering on earth. The only way to escape from suffering is the Realization that we are not even the Mind and Ego, ME that is directing action. The moment we Realize the Truth of 'Who am I?' we are liberated from all Karma and all suffering, just as we are liberated from rehirth

When we realize that we are not the body nor are we the mind and ego that is creating Karma, we are the Divine Soul, then there is no Karma in our account. We become a Karma Yogi, an instrument of God, our actions are inspired by God, and we seek nothing from our actions. In this case, we are liberated from Karma, from suffering and from rebirth.

Karma does not belong to the Body, at Death, the body is Free... Karma belongs to the Mind and Ego that says, 'It's me!'



#### WHY DOES A NEWBORN CHILD SUFFER?



Have you ever wondered why there is so much suffering in some newborn babies who have done no Karma? They are just born. Then why are they blind, deaf, dumb, physically handicapped or even born in utter poverty? What has this little child done? Many people ask this question and wonder. Those who understand Karma, they don't. They accept and they surrender.

Those who are ignorant about the Law of Karma even blame God for being cruel, unjust or unfair. They don't Realize the Truth about Karma. They don't realize that this little child is not the one who has done Karma. But the Mind and Ego, ME that was conceived 9 months ago in the womb of this child's mother, carried unsettled Karma that had to be redeemed. Therefore, it is not fair to blame God. If we have a Karma that must be settled, we have to pay for it. If we do not pay for our Karma in this life, there is no other option but to carry the Karma forward and take a new birth in the circumstance of a real hell right here on earth. It seems to us that the newborn child is suffering. No doubt it is. But suffering of the body is a part of this drama called 'life'. Every 'body' that is born will suffer all kinds of aches and pains. From the time we grow up, we fall as we grow tall, and we experience diseases as part of living in a body. Ultimately the body will decay and die. Suffering is a part of human life. Although suffering is interspersed with happiness and life is a yoyo of joy and sorrow, nobody can escape from suffering.

Therefore, those who understand Karma properly, know that the only way to escape from suffering is to escape from being born as a child who will suffer. They know that they will experience the triple suffering of the body, mind and ego and therefore, they try to be liberated from Karma and from the constant cycle of death and rebirth.

Not only does the newborn child suffer, but the parents also suffer great misery. 'Why are the parents suffering for the child's past Karma?' people wonder. The parents are not suffering the child's Karma. If the parents are suffering, it must be because of their Karma. Suffering doesn't appear without a corresponding Karma. When we see a newborn child suffer due to the circumstances of its birth, we should realize how Karma controls everything. It makes no mistake. If our Karma is not settled now, we cannot escape from our Karma, and this may last for several lifetimes. There is only one solution - if we realize we are not the body that suffers, we are not even the mind and ego that is reborn, we are the Divine Soul, in that very moment of Realization, all our past Karma gets dissolved. It may be the carried forward Karma of many lifetimes, but the moment we Realize the Truth of who we are, we are free from Karma. Such is the Law. Unfortunately, a very tiny fraction of humanity goes deep into understanding Karma. When those who don't understand Karma see a newborn child suffer, they look up at the sky and with anger, question, 'Why?' They will not Realize the Truth till they get the real answer to the question -'Who am I?'

Why does a newborn child suffer?

#### IS GOD CRUEL AND UNJUST, OR JUST NOT POWERFUL ENOUGH?



We human beings are so ignorant that we even question the authority of the Creator we call God. We have the audacity to believe that God is cruel, God is unjust. We even question God's power when we see something unfair unfolding on earth. Because of our ignorance about Karma, we don't realize that it is Karma unfolding and not God's cruelty.

Some philosophers try to understand why bad things happen to good people. They question – 'Is God cruel? Is God unjust? Is God not powerful enough to control bad things from happening?' Those who believe in God and pray, do not consider God to be unjust or cruel. They love God. But they sometimes wonder whether God is powerful enough to stop the devil from causing suffering on earth. They even believe that there is a tussle between God in heaven and the devil in hell. They imagine a kind of war that causes suffering on earth. When will we overcome our ignorance to realize that God is omnipotent, all-powerful; God is omniscient, all-knowing; God is omnipresent, present everywhere!

As long as we do not Realize the Truth about God, we will doubt God and we will continue to go to a temple and church and search for a God in a statue or a saint. Till we realize that God is a Power beyond our comprehension, we may continue to doubt God's justice and power. But this is our foolishness!

Those who understand the Law of Karma, know beyond doubt that God lives in the temple of our heart. God knows everything that is happening. However, God has given us a free will. He has given us an intellect. We human beings are

the only ones who are blessed to make a choice. But once we do, then the Law of Karma kicks in. Whatever be our action, we have to face the reaction. The Law of Karma works not only during our lifetime, but also carries forward beyond death into our rebirth. Karma is everything. It is life, death, birth and it goes on and on. It is a Universal Law created by God to create order on earth. Instead of appreciating the just Law of Karma, we human beings, in our ignorance, misinterpret what we see happening on earth and then, blame God for it. # CAN WE CIRCUMVENT KARMA?



Nobody can escape from Karma - whoever you are and wherever you live, whatever be your nationality or your religion, your financial status or your political clout. Nobody on earth can escape from Karma!

Karma is a Universal Law. It is not like the 'law of the land'. America has different laws compared to China, just as Hindus, Muslims and Christians have different laws. But the Law of Karma applies to all, irrespective of caste, creed, religion and gender. The Law is simple. Whatever you do, it will come back to you. Whatever you give, you will get. If the Law is so simple, then why does the world not accept this Law?

Most people in the world accept Karma, but some people still don't believe in it. They believe in some parts of the Law, but don't understand it completely. The Law of Karma is stringent, and nobody can circumvent it. You can find a way to continue your journey when the highway is blocked. But when Karma blocks your life, you have to stop! Karma controls our birth. Karma also controls our death. Karma controls everything that happens on earth. We have to accept it. We have to surrender to Karma. We have no option!

What then are the ways to escape from Karma? The only way is to negate Karma. If we do good Karma, it can delete the bad Karma in our account. That is not escaping Karma, but it is making good for the past bad deeds that we have done.

Very few people in this world realize the secret of circumventing Karma. Though it is not actually circumventing

Karma because you cannot cheat Karma. It is being liberated from Karma. This rare minority tries to understand who Karma actually belongs to. They go on a quest, and they realize that Karma doesn't belong to the body. Although it seems like the body is doing the Karma, and the body is also experiencing the fruit of the Karma, they first realize that it is ME, the Mind and Ego that is responsible for Karma. Therefore, at death, the body is destroyed, but the account of Karma continues, as the ME, Mind and Ego takes a new birth in a new body, to settle the Karma.

They further probe Karma and Realize the Truth that Karma doesn't even belong to ME, the Mind and Ego. This is caused by our ignorance. We believe in *Maya*, the cosmic illusion and think we are the doers of action. In reality, we are nothing. We are just Divine Energy, the Soul. When we realize this, we are enlightened and liberated from Karma. This means, all our Karma, the Karma of all our lifetimes, drops like a bag of potatoes, sinks and disappears in the ocean of life. We are liberated from Karma, from all suffering, while alive and liberated from rebirth at death. This is the only way to circumvent Karma. Other than this, there is no way to escape Karma, no way to escape from Rebirth. We have to suffer for our deeds both when we are alive and even after we are dead.

Karma is a Universal Law, we can't escape from it. Whoever we are, wherever we go, by Karma we will be hit.



### ARE WE CARRYING KARMA OF SEVERAL LIVES?

Some people wonder how it is possible to carry Karma of several lives. They don't understand how the Law of Karma works. The fact is that nobody does. There are many Universal Laws and only the Creator knows how they work. We can only experience the unfolding of these laws but cannot decode the essence or principles on which God has created them.

What do we see unfolding in the world? Don't we see only apples growing on apple trees? Don't we see the Law of the Boomerang in action – what goes around, comes around? Our common sense tells us that everything that is happening in this world is not happening by luck or chance. It is not even happening by the random acts of God. God is controlling this universe through Divine Laws without anybody intervening in how they unfold.

When we see bad things happening to good people, how do we react? We are shocked and disappointed. But what do we do? *Priya was a young girl. At 35, she slept one night, never to wake up. She left behind beautiful children, who now had no mother. Her family and friends cried – 'O God, how can you be so unfair?'* 

When we see incidents like this, don't we wonder, 'How does God manage the show? Why does he permit the scoundrels and murderers to get away and allow innocent people to suffer?' We don't use our common sense to understand that everything that is happening is unfolding as per Karma. It is not some random bad luck, some curse nor is it some voodoo magic or the use of supernatural powers that creates what is called black magic. All these are fairy tales. This is not the Truth.

When a rose appears on a tree, there is no magic! It appears because of the seed we planted. If a thorn appears in our life, we should not wonder or blame God or be fooled by fairy tales. The thorns that are appearing in our life are because of the deeds we have planted. There is no other reason.

Because we do not remember some of our actions that were done in the distant past, and further because we cannot recall the deeds of our past life, we don't realize why good or bad things are happening to us. Those who understand Karma, realize that the reactions in our life are because of our own past actions. They might have been committed by us in our previous life, wherein we died without settling our Karma.

Does Karma end at death? No! Only the body dies, but the one who leaves the body, our subtle existence ME, the Mind and Ego, carries its Karma onward. In fact, these cumulative accounts of Karma, together become a corpus, a warehouse from which our new birth on earth is decided. There is no going to heaven or hell and meeting a God who will order justice. The Divine has created an automatic system where we carry our Karma, life after life, to be settled through a rebirth on earth.

Does our Karma end, the moment our body is dead? No, it is carried forward life after life, as the wise men have said.



## WHAT ARE THE THREE ACCOUNTS OF KARMA?



Karma has 3 accounts. The first account that we all understand is the Current account. It is just like a bank account. There are debits and credits. We cannot escape from the recovery officer of the bank. If we have taken a loan, he will hound us till he collects the same. The recovery system of Karma is much stronger. There is no way to escape. Every good deed and every bad deed that we do in this world is settled and Karma makes no mistake. This current account of Karma is easy to understand. But what happens when we die? What happens to all our pending Karma? If we die in this world leaving liabilities, people to whom we owe money, we will have to write it off, because we are no more and nobody else guaranteed our loans. But Karma doesn't write off our bad deeds or our sins. These are recorded along with our good deeds and are transferred into the account of the Mind and Ego, ME that departs at death. Aren't we sure that the one who was alive, left? If we weren't, we would not destroy the body. While we are clear about people departing at death, not many of us know that the one who departs carries their pending Karma into the life beyond.

Every lifetime has a residual Karma, good or bad, that gets carried forward into our Karmic Corpus. This is the second account of Karma. It is like a warehouse of ME, the Mind and Ego. Every time it completes one life, it carries unsettled Karma that is added to the previous unsettled Karma of its previous lives. What happens next?

Don't we see somebody being born on earth in fortunate or unfortunate circumstances? A child may be born in a palace or a slum. A child may be blind or very healthy. Our circumstances of birth are not a matter of chance. We start our new journey on earth with a third account of Karma, our Opening Balance that we bring from our corpus or warehouse of Karma. If the corpus has good Karma that was created by good deeds that we did in our lifetime, then those good deeds, if not rewarded during our life, get credited into our corpus. In such a case, the third account or opening balance of Karma which commences at birth, may start in fortunate circumstances because our corpus had good Karma in it. However, if our corpus only had bad Karma, then our new journey on earth, our birth would carry an opening balance of negative Karma which we will have to suffer.

Every human being has these 3 accounts of Karma. The opening balance that we start with, merges with the current account. These two accounts determine the good and bad that unfolds in our life every day. The third account or corpus is sealed. At death, whatever is our closing balance – a tally of our opening balance and our current account, which includes all our good and bad deeds after settling, becomes the closing balance. At death, this closing balance is added to our corpus from which our rebirth is decided. It is important to understand these 3 accounts of Karma, to understand our birth, and everything else that happens on earth.

Karma has three accounts, an opening balance with which we are born, Second, the account of current actions and the third that goes on and on.



# WHAT IS THE CONNECTION BETWEEN KARMA AND REBIRTH?

Is there any connection between our birth and our Karma? Many people think that Karma is only to do with what happens in life. Sure, it is! But what about birth? compassionate as he understood how the Law of Karma works. He never sinned and never lost an opportunity to serve others. He became a wealthy executive and not only did he transform his life, but also bought a new house for his parents, and grew out of the poverty syndrome by Realizing the Truth of Karma.

We hear of many such stories, don't we? But what we don't realize is that everything that happens on earth happens because of Karma. Good or bad, whatever is unfolding in our life is not a matter of chance. It is not even just prayers. While prayers are a good Karma, if we only pray but do not follow up with deeds of Divinity, then our prayers will not be fruitful.

When will we realize that we do not control our birth, Karma does! Who controls our Karma? We do! We have a free will, the power to choose and the power to act. If it is the Mind and Ego, ME that is carrying Karma, how is the Soul connected to this? Is the Soul also a part of the mind and ego that carries Karma life after life? Is the Soul also responsible for creating Karma? No! The Soul is in no way connected to Karma. We must be absolutely clear about the role of the Soul.

#### HOW IS KARMA TRANSFERRED AT DEATH?

Those who get into the depth of Karma, start asking many relevant questions just as they realize more and more about the truth of Karma. They ask the question, 'If we are not the body that is constantly changing and ultimately dies, and the Karma belongs to the Mind and Ego, ME that directs the body to act, then how is it possible after death or even at death that Karma is transferred from one body to another?' Let us analyze.

Aren't we sure that Karma doesn't belong to a body that is dead? The body lays on the bed and is cremated or buried and destroyed. What happens to Karma? We are also sure that the one who was alive has left the body, has departed, expired or passed away. Two questions need to be answered. Who has left the body? Where have they gone?

Most of humanity does not Realize the Truth that they are the Soul. Thus, they move from one body to another body, as their mind and ego carries their Karma. Where does the ME, the Mind and Ego go? Those who believe in the fairy tales believe in a heaven and hell somewhere up in the stars. However, those who rationalize, Realize the Truth that the body is destroyed. There is no 'body' left to go to a heaven or hell. However, as per the Law of Karma, the Karma is not deleted. It belongs to the mind and ego that left the body at death. Where did the ME, the Mind and Ego go carrying its Karma? If we search, there is only one possibility. When we look at a baby being born, we realize that the child may be a newborn baby, but it is carrying a past Karma that decides the circumstance of its birth, positive or negative. The little child

suffers or rejoices, not by chance but by Karma, carried by the mind and ego that is born in this little child. There is no other possibility and therefore, this truth is inferred.

The final question remains as to how is the Karma transferred? When our mobile phone gets old, and before we throw it away, we transfer everything from it to the new phone- the software, the apps, the data from the old device to a new device. We all use wireless technology to transfer our data carefully before the old device is discarded as dead. How does this happen? There is no wire or physical transfer. The subtle aspect of our mobile, the software transfers through waves. So does our Karma, along with the mind and ego. At death, the mind and ego carry its Karma and is transferred to a zygote, a single cell of existence conceived in the womb of a mother, to be ultimately born on earth. Those who Realize the Truth understand this simple transfer of mind and ego along with Karma, from one body that is dying to another body that is just about to be born. Those who live in ignorance think of this as a very far-fetched idea and are unable to digest the Truth of life and death and of Karma, the Law that goes beyond life and death. If a human being can use wireless technology to transfer data from one hardware to another, surely it is not difficult for the Divine to transfer Karma when one ME, Mind and Ego moves from one body to another, to fulfil the cycle of this drama that unfolds on earth.

Just as by wireless, we transfer to our new device, and our data we find.
So our Karma is transferred to a New Body, along with our Ego and Mind.



#### **IS KARMA PUNITIVE?**

The next question that arises – Is Karma meant to punish us for our sins? Why is God so cruel to create such a draconian law that makes us suffer on earth? Why has he created the human body that is capable of having passions and desires with senses that fall prey to the attractions of the material world that He has created? Thereafter, why has He created the trap of Karma where we sin and suffer not only in this earth, but we have to return again and again to suffer life after life? People do not understand the logic as to why God has created so much suffering for us human beings.

There is no doubt that there is a positive aspect of it too. Karma not only punishes us, but also rewards us. All good deeds are recorded and rewarded. But when we look around, it becomes obvious that there is far more suffering caused by Karma than celebration or joy. What is the cause that there is so much *Dukkha* or suffering on the planet? We are the Divine Soul. This realization will liberate us from all Karma and unite us with the Divine. For us to analyze and accept our own belief system on the same, we have to understand the concept of life and death. The mountains and the rivers are eternal. They are neither born nor do they die. They have no Soul. But human beings and all other living creatures seem to have a Soul that arrives at birth and departs at death. Each cycle of life seems to be caused due to a reason, just as happiness and unhappiness are not a matter of chance at the birth of a human being.

What causes a dog to be born as a dog? When a dog suffers, it cannot even express that it has pain in its kidney. What causes this suffering? Those who look deeply in the eyes of an animal or even a fish that struggles to live when it is caught and about to be slaughtered, realize that there is something behind their suffering. Is it their past Karma? Nobody knows! But definitely, there is a possibility that it may be so.

Therefore, it is for us to believe or not to believe that we may be reborn as an animal due to Karma. But there is no doubt that if we sin, our bad deeds will cause us to live a dog's life in our next birth. Therefore, our goal must be to escape from returning to earth. We must aspire to be liberated from Karma and all suffering when we are alive and ultimately, when we die, and the body returns to dust, we must be liberated from the cycle of Karma and rebirth and be united with the Divine.

Instead of worrying,

'What if I am reborn as a dog, a pig or a fish?'

We must go in quest and be Enlightened,

and not just worry or wish.



## DO ALL LIVING BEINGS CREATE KARMA?



The Law of Karma is based on important principles of *Karta* and *Bhokta*. What do these mean? Just like Karma means action, *Karta* means the doer of action and *Bhokta* means one who receives the fruits of action. Normally *Bhokta* is used in the negative sense when one suffers due to their past Karma. But the principle remains the same.

Who creates Karma? Karma means action. Therefore, does it mean that anybody and everybody who performs action creates Karma? No! Karma is not created unless there is a 'Conscious' action. For any action done unconsciously or inadvertently, there is no Karma. Take, for instance, a man shooting an arrow at his target. He is practising the art of archery, honing his skills and therefore, continues several attempts at shooting. Just as he is shooting, a bird comes in front of his arrow and dies. Is it his Karma? He did not intend to kill the bird. It was the bird's Karma to come in front of his arrow and die.

Therefore, it must be understood that only a *Karta*, the doer of action who consciously chooses to act will create good Karma or bad Karma, based on a combination of both his intention and action. We may be driving a car, and suddenly, a reptile crosses the road and is crushed under our back wheel. Surely it is unfortunate, but it is not recorded as our Karma.

This brings us to the next question – do animals create Karma? A tiger constantly hunts the deer. Lizards catch flies, just as many seabirds use their long beaks to kill fish. If we use our intelligence to introspect, we will realize that the Creator has created many living organisms that live by instinct, not

intellect. They have not been given the power of discrimination. They have only been created with a particular set of natural habits and they live accordingly. They do not create Karma. They are not *Karta* – the doer of an action. However, it seems like they are *Bhokta* – the experiencer. Maybe they are born in that life to experience their past Karma. But this is not something that is known to us for sure. What we can be sure about is that they are not creating Karma.

Even a human being who is not acting out of his discrimination is not a *Karta* or creator of Karma. Both, a young child who has not developed its intellect, and an adult who is mentally challenged and not acting out of discrimination, do not create Karma through their actions. They are *Bhokta*, experiencing their Karma, but they are not *Karta*.

Therefore, we must be careful of the conscious actions we choose to do. Once we perform an act, our Karma is recorded and cannot be undone. We have to pay for it, redeem it, if not in this life, then in the next. While nobody is sure whether we can be born as a pig, a fish or a chicken, it is for us to decide whether we would like to slaughter them and have them on our plate. Many choose not to devour the flesh of animals in the fear that they would be beheaded in an equally cruel manner as per the Law of Karma.

Karma is an action that is done by an intelligent mind, Not by kids or animals or the mentally challenged, they are free from this grind.



## IS KARMA TRANSFERABLE?



Sometimes, we wish that our near and dear ones be free from the suffering of life. We cannot bear to see their suffering and we pray that our good deeds be settled against their bad Karma. Is Karma transferrable? Unfortunately, no. Sadly, the Law of Karma does not permit somebody's good deeds to settle somebody's sins. If we sin, we cannot win. We have to pay the price of our deeds. There is no other way to settle the Karma.

Often parents try to go to orphanages, old age homes and blind schools to serve the destitute and the suffering. They do this because they are blessed with a child who is not so blessed. The child may be suffering from a serious disease. They think that their good Karma will wipe out the negative Karma of their child, whose life circumstances are harsh. While this compassion is understandable, we must realize that the Law of Karma is not transferable. My Karma is my Karma, and you can do nothing about it! I have to face the consequences of my past action. Somebody else's Karma or prayers cannot negate my negative deeds.

The world has moved a long way and you can transfer money from your account to anybody's account. You can help people who are suffering economically or financially, anywhere in the world, but you can't transfer Karma to anybody's account. In that sense, our Karmic account is sealed. Unlike our bank account that can receive funds from others, our Karmic account cannot. We can take a few currency notes from our wallet and put them into somebody else's pocket, but can we do the same with Karma?

Karma works more like our passport or ID card. You cannot travel with somebody else's passport, or somebody else's ID card cannot gain for you access to a place which is exclusive. The reason is this – we have done our Karma with our own free will. It was our choice. Now we have to pay for it. Therefore, we must be very careful with our actions. Once the action is performed, it is on our head till we are dead. Karma is so particular that even after we die, the Karma moves with us from one body to another till we settle our Karma.

Sometimes, we think of Karma unfolding to many people together. We think it is a joint Karma or group Karma when 100 people die in an air crash. This does not necessarily mean that all 100 had performed the same sin for receiving the same reaction. There must have been an action that each of them did that deserved this kind of a Karmic reaction.

When we are born in this world, we come alone and when we die, we go alone. We may get married and we may be part of a family, but our Karma doesn't get diluted or merged. It is exclusively our Karma and neither can we give our good or bad Karma to others, nor can we receive it from them. We have to settle our own Karma.

Can you transfer Karma like you transfer money to a bank? No, Karma is an individual subject... you can only fill your tank.



## CAN PRAYER CHANGE KARMA?



Very often we pray, 'O Lord, please forgive our dear ones for their sins.' Will our prayers create forgiveness for somebody who has bad Karma recorded in their account? While prayers are very good and we must develop the habit of praying, we must realize that prayer can do little when it comes to Karma. Prayer can strengthen us, can build in us power to face any circumstance caused by Karma. But prayers cannot delete Karma directly.

So, what is more powerful – prayer or action? When we view prayer itself as an action, then we realize that the act of praying becomes a good Karma. However, this is a good Karma only for us. Prayer cannot work as a remote control to change somebody else's Karma. We can pray for forgiveness for our sins, but we must realize that while the Lord forgives, He wants us to transform through our suffering before forgiveness kicks in. The act of prayer itself is magical. It is communicating with the Lord. But the way it works is that prayer must transform us, lead us to better actions, and thereby attract the rewards of Karma as per the process of action and reaction.

Imagine the whole world starts praying to God to be forgiven for their sins. There would be burglars, murderers, and rapists, all praying to God to be forgiven. But what about their Karma? Therefore, God has created Karma to be stronger than prayer. In a way, there can be no better prayer than Karma. Vivekanand, an Indian Saint, very rightly said that 'Shiva Jnane Jiva Seva,' that 'Service to humanity is prayer to God.' Those who serve are in effect performing a more

effective prayer than chanting in a temple, singing in a church or meditating in a monastery. Unfortunately, we don't understand the meaning of prayer. Prayer is not a scheme to move God to act. It is a two-way communication with God. But if we are disobeying God's commandments, living unethical and immoral lives, with bad deeds that create negative Karma, then we should not expect prayer to be magical.

Some people get fooled and believe that by contributing 10% of their income as tithes to the church or contribution to their religious institution, they will be forgiven for their sins and the Lord will suffer on their behalf. This is a myth. We must not believe in it. Let us remember that the hands that serve can do a lot more than the lips that pray. Instead of using our hands to turn the beads of a rosary, we must use them in doing good Karma, because this act is far more powerful than the act of chanting God's name. God wants us to pray but God also wants our prayers to make us better human beings, who live with kindness, compassion, and love. On the one hand, doing bad Karma and on the other hand, praying is taking us in two opposite directions.

Prayer cannot change Karma. But it can change the one who is doing the Karma. Prayer cannot perform any magic to make our bad Karma disappear. Let us do both, do good Karma and pray, and we are sure to realize God. Otherwise, we will spend the rest of our life, praying, chanting and shedding tears in entreaty to a God who actually wants us to perform good Karma and then ultimately be Enlightened.

Prayer is powerful but can it change the Karma of your past?
Prayers can give us strength to face our problems while they last.



#### CAN GOOD KARMA NEGATE BAD KARMA?



The Law of Karma provides that we have an opportunity to set off every sin with a good deed. Therefore, it is not a hopeless, irreversible law. While we cannot escape from it, we can settle our bad Karma with good Karma.

Roger did wrong to a lot of people. He cheated people in business deals with them and even broke several hearts in his personal relationships. He had no ethics and morals. If one looked at his Karmic score, he had negative marks against most of his actions. The Law of Action and Reaction did not spare him. He suffered both in his business and in his personal life as his wife left him. Roger was shaken.

One day, he met a Spiritual Master to understand why life was so unfair. The Master explained that life was like a mirror. Whatever you will be, that you will see in the mirror. Whatever you put in life, will come out of it. Roger started to transform his actions. He became kind and compassionate. He reached out to the destitute and suffering. He started creating good Karma. His life was transformed. The world around him changed, as people saw a new Roger. Haven't we seen this happen around us? What goes around, comes around! Karma is like a boomerang.

While we understand all this, some of us do not realize that Karma is reformative, not punitive. The Law does not intend for us to suffer. Therefore, if we settle our bad deeds with good deeds, we can escape from suffering. But what if we do not settle our bad deeds. Then, we will even have to return to earth in a rebirth to settle our deeds.

Those who don't understand the Law of Karma must reflect on how our credit card system works. Every expense is a debit in our account and every deposit is a credit. The bank records all transactions and as long as we can deposit amounts that equal our expenses and we settle our dues, the bank does not trouble us. So it is with Karma. Good Karma can negate the bad Karma, but unfortunately, unlike in a bank where we can calculate and pay, in life we don't have a statement of Karma and our negative score inadvertently, becomes so high that when we die, we carry it forward into a rebirth. The irony is that even if there is good Karma, we have to come back to earth and whoever comes to earth must suffer. Therefore, the ultimate goal is that we should have no Karma.

Because death is definite but sudden, there is always some Karma in our account and to settle this Karma, we are reborn. Before the final moment, every human being must try to do good Karma, so that the bad Karma is negated and there is no suffering here on earth. To avoid suffering in a rebirth, one should not end their life without doing enough good deeds that settle their bad deeds in their account of Karma. Some people who believe in Karma, do not understand that they can negate negative Karma through positive deeds. Because of this hopelessness, they continue to live without being inspired to do good deeds and to create a new destiny.

Just like we can deposit cash in our bank to settle our credit card spend, We can do good Karma and delete our bad Karma till our very end.



## WHY SHOULD WE TRANSCEND KARMA?



What would you prefer? Would you prefer to return to earth and suffer the triple suffering of the body, mind and ego, or would you choose to be liberated from the eternal suffering of life? We have a choice. Either we can understand the Law of Karma or live in ignorance and continue to sin, but we must remember we will never win. We may achieve the pleasures of this material world, but ultimately, we will cry. We question, 'Why?' not realizing that every 'body' that comes to earth must suffer. Everything that is happening around us is happening because of Karma. How can we escape from this constant cycle of death and rebirth? How can we be free from all the suffering that we experience on earth?

As long as we are alive, we will keep on creating Karma, both good and bad. Man cannot escape from action, and actions produce both positive and negative Karma. Ultimately, at death, our deeds, both good and bad will cause our rebirth on earth. Most of us do not realize that we get caught in this cycle. We do not understand that our ultimate goal is to escape from this cycle. What is the way to escape?

The way to escape from rebirth and from returning to earth is transcending Karma. We should go beyond Karma. Although we do actions, we must realize that these are not our actions. Karma does not belong to us. Unless we Realize the Truth of who we are, we cannot transcend Karma. Therefore, the only way to transcend Karma is the realization that we are not the body that does Karma, not the Mind and Ego, ME that directs Karma, we are the Divine Soul. This Realization frees us from all Karma. Without this Realization, there is no way we can

She did not realize that one day, she would die, but she will not escape from the cycle of rebirth. She would have to come back to earth. If her Karmic account was positive, based on not just her Karma as Nisha, but also her previous lives, then she would be born in pleasant circumstances. But would her fortunate new birth on earth free her from all future suffering? No! Everybody on earth suffers. We must Realize this Truth and therefore, like Nisha, we should not just do good Karma and think we have achieved our goal.

Our goal is to transcend Karma. We must realize that while it is much better to do good Karma than bad Karma, our positive Karmic score can only do that much to bring us back to earth in a good life. However, our goal is Liberation. It is Unification with the Divine. It is to escape from this constant cycle of birth and suffering, death and rebirth. The only way to escape is to transcend Karma. How can we go beyond Karma? By dropping all Karma and by realizing that we are not the doers of action. When we do not create any new Karma and realize we are the Divine Soul, then we have achieved our ultimate goal. We should live as the instrument of the Divine, Realizing the Truth about life. #### IS FREEDOM FROM KARMA - LIBERATION?



The Law of Karma is not very easy to understand. First, we must understand the basics of the Law. Then, we must understand who the Karma belongs to. Then, we should try to transcend Karma. Then, we must realize that we are not the doers of Karma. But even after all this, is the Realization enough for Liberation? Once we realize we are not the doer of Karma, we drop all Karma. We transcend Karma. Are we then free from all future Karma? It depends if we have been enlightened with the Truth or not.

Very few people are blessed with Enlightenment. They live a life of self-realization, realizing that they are not the body, mind and ego. They are the Divine Soul. Thereafter, they have no Karma. Yes, Karma makes us live as the Mind and Ego, and separates us from our Lord. We remain ignorant of who we truly are, and we don't Realize God.

Death is certain and it is also certain that the body disintegrates into dust. The question we must ask is – Who goes to heaven or hell if there is no body? Who will be rewarded or punished once we leave the body? Once our existence is over, once we burn or bury the dead body, how do we meet God? We have been taught fairy tales that the body will reappear to face the consequences after life. But we know beyond doubt that this is a myth. The only possibility is that we are rewarded or punished on earth through rebirth. Heaven and hell do exist, but they are right here on earth and the only way for us to be rewarded or punished is to carry our Karma forward into a new birth.

obvious that it is Karma that is causing these circumstances at birth. This is called inference. We throw a ball up in the air and we infer that it is being pulled down due to gravity. Our logical inference itself becomes the proof of our conclusion.

Therefore, what happens to Karma at death? The body dies, but the Karma doesn't die. The one who leaves the body carries Karma forward and appears in a new body, to settle Karma, both good and bad. This Karmic cycle continues life after life, till we realize that we are not the ME, the Mind and Ego that is carrying the Karma. This is called Enlightenment. This Realization liberates us from our ignorance. It frees us from our ego. The moment 'I' don't exist, then obviously I don't have any Karma. When we realize we are not the body that dies, nor are we the mind and the ego that says 'I', then we do not do any Karma, nor do we accumulate Karma. Even the past Karma of several lives disappears because we have transcended 'I', the ego, along with the mind. When there is no body at death, and there is no ME, Mind and Ego, then there is no Karma. At death, when the body disintegrates, we, the Divine Soul, the Spirit or the Atman, will become one with the Lord. We will not return to earth in a rebirth because we have dropped all our Karma as we have dropped all our ignorance. This is the ultimate secret of Karma, that we must learn, just as it is the ultimate secret of life.

The body dies, it has no Karma,
it returns to dust.
For the mind and ego that must redeem its Karma,
Rebirth is a Must.



## HOW CAN WE BE FREE FROM KARMA?



Once we have understood that our ultimate goal is to realize that we are the Divine Soul and to be free from rebirth on earth, then the question is — 'How can we be free from the loads of Karma that we carry life after life? How can we be free from all the suffering that we have to undergo due to our sins?' There is a way. It is called Enlightenment.

Enlightenment is nothing but the Realization of the Truth. It is the Realization that we are not this body that dies. One who is enlightened, realizes that he was conceived 9 months before the body arrived. The body was formed cell by cell over the 40 weeks in the womb. He realizes that one day, this body will die, and people will say, 'He passed away.' He questions who is the one who leaves the body and passes away.

While the enlightened one realizes that he is not the body, he is also blessed to realize that he is not the Mind and Ego, ME that carries Karma life after life, as it leaves one body and takes birth in another. He questions the existence of the mind and as he tries to find the mind, he realizes that it doesn't exist. It is just a bundle of thoughts that appears as his mind. He asks the question – 'Who am I?' and he is spiritually flabbergasted to Realize the Truth that 'I am not 'I'. I am nothing. Neither am I the body that comes and goes nor am I the mind, that I cannot find. I am just a manifestation of Divine Energy that appears on this earth and is trapped in Maya. He realizes 'I am trapped in this cosmic illusion which is nothing but a projection of energy.' This realization liberates the enlightened one, not only from his ignorance, that he is not the body, mind and ego, but also liberates him

from Karma. This Realization that he is neither the body nor the ME, the Mind and Ego that carries its Karma, frees him from all previous Karma and unites him with the Divine at death.

Suppose you have a dream and in that dream, you have two children and they both slip into a deep well behind your house. When you wake up from the dream, will you run to the well to pull the children out? Of course you won't, because neither the dream exists nor the children. It was just an illusion. So is our life on earth. Those who are not on the path of Enlightenment will find this very difficult to understand and digest. They will be caught in the cycle of Karma, and they will be born again and again and suffer a rebirth on earth. Unless we are enlightened with the Truth, we can never be free from Karma, nor can we be free from the suffering on earth. If we want to achieve the ultimate goal of Liberation from suffering, and we want to attain that Divine unification to become one with our Lord, we have to overcome our ignorance. We have to understand the simple Truth that we are not the body that dies and disintegrates. We are not even the Mind and Ego that appears to be ME. Everything is a Divine show. We are just actors who come and go. Once we Realize the Truth, then we are free from Karma. At death, we will not carry the Karma forward into another chapter in the book of life as we are enlightened.

We can be free from Karma, if only we are enlightened with the Truth. When we realize we are Soul, not body, mind and ego... when we get to the root.



# WHAT IS THE ULTIMATE GOAL OF LIFE?

Those who read about Karma ask the profound question -What is the goal of our life? Those who are on the path of Enlightenment, seek to know the answer – 'Why do we come to earth? Are we just born so that we will be gone or is there a purpose for us on earth?' Only those who are sincere seekers of the Truth move forward on the journey to realize the ultimate goal that we are the Divine Soul. The rest of us just live and die and we don't know why. We don't realize that all this is Maya, the cosmic illusion created by the Creator. We don't understand the Divine Leela, the drama that is unfolding on this humongous stage called the earth, where 8 billion actors wake up every morning to do their act. Just like every actor performs his role, we human beings continue to perform our Karma without realizing we are just actors on the earth stage. While the actor knows his true identity and is detached from the role he plays in the drama, we have forgotten our true identity that we are not the body, mind and ego, we are the Divine Soul. We think that this drama of life is real and we get attached to possessions and people, not realizing that it is just a show. Although we know that we will come and we will go, that nothing belongs to us, that all relationships will end, that we come alone and we go alone, we are so trapped in our ignorance that we are unable to Realize the Truth. The goal of human life is this – it is the Realization of who we are and why we are here. Our goal is to be enlightened that we are not the body, mind and ego and the Karma doesn't belong to us. Our goal is to be free from the cycle of death and rebirth. That is the very purpose of coming to earth.

Once we are born in this Samsaar, we forget we are the Divine

Soul. We are so encapsulated in the body-mind complex, that we lose the consciousness of our true identity. We get so trapped in the *Maya*, the ignorance, that we create Karma, and we get caught in this *Leela* and return to earth again and again. The fact is that the Creator has created all this because it is His way of continuing the drama that unfolds on earth. While He has given us an opportunity to be enlightened, He has also given us five senses that create desires. He has given us a mind that wanders and He has given us an ego that gets trapped. If we truly love our Lord, and we yearn to realize God, only then will we go in quest of the Truth and overcome the ignorance. Only then, will we realize we are not the body, mind and ego. Only then will we be free from all Karma, from this *Leela*, from *Maya*, free from rebirth and we will not return to earth.

This is our ultimate goal – to overcome our ignorance and realize we are the Divine Soul, to live as a *Karma Yogi* who is free from all Karma while alive and ultimately at death, not to return, but rather become one with our Lord. A very few amongst us are fortunate to reach this state of Realization, Liberation and Unification. This is our ultimate goal – to live a Spiritual life in this material world, to be enlightened with the Truth, to be free from all misery and suffering and to attain that state of eternal happiness and everlasting peace.

Did we come to earth for nothing, or is there a purpose, is there a goal?

Yes, we have to be liberated from ignorance and realize we are the Soul.



# WHO IS A KARMA YOGI?



Look around you. Most human beings are just living a life doing Karma. They may be doing good Karma or bad Karma. Not only does this world have sinners, burglars, murderers, rapists, but this world also has kind and compassionate people who live with morals, ethics, and values. All these people do Karma, good and bad. Their Karma is recorded and unfolds as circumstances in their life. Their Karma also controls their rebirth on earth. They go through the cycle of pleasure and pain, as they are born again and again as per their Karma.

A Karma Yogi is different. While he appears to be like any other human being, he has been enlightened with the Truth. After realizing that he is not the body, mind and ego, he is the Divine Soul, is he free from action? No! Like anybody else, he continues to perform Karma. But he realizes that Karma is not his. He lives as an instrument of God, doing the Divine will. Therefore, he does not create Karma. He has given up all desires and cravings, having Realized the Truth about life. Therefore, while he acts as a Divine instrument, he expects no rewards for his actions. Since he seeks no fruits, he becomes free from Karma. None of his Karma is his because he realizes he is nothing. He is just a manifestation of the Divine. This realization not only frees him from creating new Karma, but it also liberates him from the triple suffering that most of us experience on earth. Even though his body may experience pain, a Karma Yogi does not suffer because he realizes he is not the body. The Karma Yogi is free from the wandering of the mind because he lives in the Consciousness of the Truth that he is the Divine Soul. He transcends the ego and lives

with humility. How does the Karma Yogi do this? How is he able to live a life in this world without being trapped in the cycle of Karma?

The Karma Yogi is able to transcend Karma, escape from suffering, by living in yoga. Yoga means *Yuj* or Union. A Yogi is ever united with the Divine. Whatever actions he performs, they are not inspired by his body, mind or ego. Therefore, he becomes a Karma Yogi. A Karma Yogi has no Karma of his own. All the Karma he does is for God. In such a state, he is liberated from all past Karma. He becomes a *Jivanmukta*, one who is liberated from all suffering while alive. He lives as a *Sthitpragya*, a steady intellect that keeps him in that state of Consciousness of who he truly is. Thus, he lives a life of *SatChitAnanda*, experiencing eternal, Divine bliss, living in the ever Consciousness of the Truth.

A *Karma Yogi* has achieved the ultimate goal of life. He has moved from Self-Realization to God-Realization. He experiences God everywhere, in everything. At death, the *Karma Yogi* is not reborn. He is liberated and united with God. The goal of human life is not just to do good Karma and be happy, but to be enlightened, to live as a Karma yogi, and ultimately to attain that state of *Moksha*, Salvation or *Nirvana*. # **AFTERWORD**

I too had many questions about life – where did I come from and where will I go? Who controls my birth and my death? Why did I come to earth? Why was I blessed with a human birth? Was it Karma? Were the actions of my previous life responsible for the circumstances in this life? Did God decide where I was born? Does God live somewhere in a heaven far away? When I went on a quest to find answers to these questions, I realized the Divine Truth - Everything is Karma.

Our life is unfolding as per our past Karma, just as our present Karma is like the seeds that we are planting. They will decide what the fruits would be on the tree of our life. They will decide our destiny. Karma is a law that nobody can escape from. I realized that those who did not understand Karma will continue to suffer through life. Then came the final Realization - to achieve the ultimate goal of Liberation and Unification with God, I needed Realization that I am not this body that will die. I am not even the Mind and Ego, ME that has been carrying its Karma life after life, changing bodies in every birth. I am the Divine Soul. This Realization has liberated me from Karma. Although I perform actions, I am not creating any new Karma because I am just an instrument of the Divine that is acting on His behalf. I do nothing and seek no rewards for what I am doing. Not only do I accept what happens in my life, realizing it is the past Karma that is unfolding, I also live a life of Divine surrender, knowing that till I am alive, whatever will happen, will unfold as per the Karma of the many past episodes of life, that I might have encountered.

I live as a Karma Yogi. To me, nothing matters. I know

nothing belongs to me. I realize that all relationships will end. I know that one day I will go because this is just a show. I have achieved the ultimate goal of realizing I am the Divine Soul. I am not the body that I wear. I am the one that wears the body. The body is an instrument that executes the Divine will. Therefore, I live in Yoga, in constant union with the Lord. I try to shut off all the worldly noise so that I can hear the Divine voice. When I get a Divine vision, I make that my mission.

While my life is all about Karma, I have transcended Karma. I have gone beyond doing Karma which is the way to lead us to the path that will lead us to our ultimate destination of Liberation from the cycle of death and rebirth and unification with the Divine. I have no doubt about all this. Not only do I know it, I realize it. Just like I see the sunset and the sunrise, and the cycle continues, I can visualize that if I continue to live without being 'I', dropping the ego, transcending the mind, going beyond the cravings and the passions of the senses, I will eventually be free at death. I will not return to earth. Such is the doctrine of Karma. While nobody can escape Karma, only those who transcend it, who Realize the Truth about the self and who discover the Truth about life, can ultimately realize God. Karma is life. Life is Karma. And if we don't understand Karma, we can never understand life.

Before I end, let me share that the Law of Karma is beyond human comprehension. Man cannot comprehend how Karma works, when Karma works, when the reaction of our action will happen. Man is even unsure, sometimes, whether it is a good Karma or a bad Karma. What we are sure about is that the Law of Karma exists and that every action will get an equal reaction whether it is in this birth or the next. Today, people are confused. They have an ailing relative who is in coma for decades. They wonder, 'Should we let euthanasia or

mercy killing end their suffering? Will this be a good Karma or bad Karma?' If there is a terrorist who is trying to kill others,'Should we kill him. Will it be a good Karma or bad Karma?' If there is a dangerous animal that is attacking us, 'Can we kill that animal in self-defence? Will it be a bad Karma?'

If we have to protect ourself from a dangerous animal, we can definitely protect ourself. But unnecessarily killing a mosquito that is in our room, is definitely a bad Karma because we are taking the life of a creature that deserves to live. Instead, we must try to repel it by taking preventive measures. Similarly hitting a dog just for fun is a bad Karma. That is intentionally, wilfully hurting a being and that is never a good deed.

Let us understand the principle by which Karma works. Any Karma, which is in self-defence cannot be a bad Karma, but any Karma which hurts others, which can be avoided, is definitely a bad Karma. Therefore, we must respect Karma, we must respect life and death. Birth and death are in the hands of the Divine, the Supreme Immortal Power that controls Karma. Therefore, we should not interfere in the life and death of anybody. We should respect their life and let them live till the Divine wishes them to live.

Finally, each one of us must use our intellect, our conscience to decide whether it is a good Karma or bad Karma. But more important than doing good Karma or bad Karma, let us not forget that we want to transcend Karma, we want to be liberated from the one who is doing the Karma, so that we are united with the Divine. This is our ultimate goal.
