Karma means action. It is a Universal Law of Action and Reaction or the Law of Cause and Effect. It is based on the Universal Principle, 'As you sow, so shall you reap.' According to this Universal Law, nothing happens by chance. Everything unfolding in this world is a result of our past actions, our Karma.

Karma is a Universal Law. Nobody can escape this law. 
Not only will Karma unfold in our life but it will also continue after we die. Our body will die but our Mind and Ego, ME, will carry Karma and return to earth in a rebirth. We will come back with a new body. Everybody who is born, suffers. We experience the triple suffering – pain of the body, misery of the mind and agony of the ego and our goal is to escape this triple suffering on earth and rebirth. But as long as there is Karma, we cannot escape rebirth. Then, how can we be free from this cycle of *Samsara*, of existence? Unless we learn the A to Z of Karma and transcend the law, unless we realize that we are not the ones who are doing the Karma, we will continue to be caught in the cycle of death and rebirth.

Who am I? Am I this body that does Karma? Or am I the mind that directs the body to act? 'The A to Z of Karma' reveals who we truly are and how we should be free, liberated from Karma, from suffering on earth and from rebirth.

There is a myth that doing good Karma will take us to God. This is a lie just like believing that God lives in the sky. 'The A to Z of Karma' will reveal the truth as it will take us to the bottom of the root.

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What is controlling this Life Drama, is our Twin Karma. Karma, we brought to earth and the Karma we did after our birth.



What is Karma? Karma means action. It is *doing*. It is not just thinking. A thought is not Karma and neither is a feeling, Karma. When a thought becomes a feeling that leads to an action, that action becomes Karma.

Karma is a very popular word in the world today because it has revealed the Law of Karma. The Law of Karma is the Law of Action and Reaction. We will discuss it in detail, later. So, what is Karma all about?

Nobody can escape from action. Every living being acts but it is only a human being who is capable of actions with discrimination. Animals, for instance, act out of instinct or some kind of a trigger but a human being not only thinks, he processes his thoughts and then, chooses his actions. These actions may be good or bad. Our life is full of actions. Nobody can escape from action. As long as we are alive, we will wake up in the morning, wash our face, brush our teeth, have a shower and get to living our life. And further, man is a social being. He will not do this alone. He constantly interacts with people and thus, his Karma or action is always connected to others. Therefore, these actions become good and bad. We do good Karma and bad Karma but we also do neutral Karma or those Karma that do not impact anybody, positively or negatively.

Little do we pay attention to Karma or action. We carelessly walk over an insect and kill it but we don't realize that our carelessness has taken the life of a little creature. Some actions are intentional and some are unintentional but still, they are actions. They are our Karma.

Can a man live without any action? Can he sleep for one year without getting out of bed? No, he can't! He has to eat, he has to cook or talk to somebody to give him food. Otherwise, he will be dead. Therefore, we cannot escape from action or Karma. Why is it so important to go so deep into the subject of Karma? It is because Karma or action doesn't stop at action alone. Every action has a reaction. Every act of ours is recorded and good or bad, we will be rewarded or punished for every deed, accordingly. A deed is like a seed. Just like every seed will sprout, every deed will bear fruit. But we don't realize this and therefore, pay scant attention to our actions. How many of us realize that life is Karma? How many of us realize that everything that is unfolding in our life is based on our Karma, our action? When we realize the truth of Karma, when we realize the A to Z of Karma or action, we will become conscious of everything that we do.


Does every animal and insect also have Karma? No! Every animal and insect perform actions but their actions are not Karma. Therefore, Karma is not just action. Karma is the action of a human being. The action of a dog is not its Karma nor is a mosquito that bites us, creating Karma for itself. Only we, human beings, accumulate Karma. Therefore, understanding Karma is the key to understanding the Law of Karma. We would laugh if somebody asked us, 'Does a car have Karma?' Why? Because we know that a car is just a machine. It may kill somebody on the road but it has no Karma. Similarly, a gun may shoot somebody and a knife may stab somebody but these are just instruments of action. We, who do the action, are creating Karma. Therefore, it is

only human beings whose actions are Karma, not the inanimate world and not the other living organisms. Therefore, we must become conscious of Karma and the Law of Karma.

People wonder, 'So, what about those who are mentally challenged or who have no intellect to discriminate?' They are not covered under the domain of Karma. Their actions do not create Karma. They are only experiencing their past Karma as they live and suffer, just like animals and other creatures do. When will we use our intelligence to understand how profound Karma is? When will we realize, how important each of our action is? When will we be enlightened that everything that we do, will come back to us? The day we realize the importance of Karma, we will take charge of our actions. We will take the responsibility of our life. We will not just do but also choose every action, consciously and intelligently. This book can transform your life. It can change the way you act and live. It will not only reveal the truth of Karma or action but will show you the way to be liberated from all suffering on earth and from rebirth.



Karma is Action and every Human Being must Act, Every Action will create a Reaction, this is a Fact!



While we have understood that Karma means action, do we realize that Karma is a law? It is not a theory. It is not a phenomenon but a Universal Law. This means that it applies to every human being on earth. Nobody can escape the Law of Karma.

It is not like a country-specific law that does not apply to the residents of another country. It applies to all sane human beings who live on planet earth. In fact, it is the very cause of our birth. Everything that happens in our life, happens because of this law but not many of us understand the A to Z of the Law of Karma.

The Law of Karma is based on the principle, 'As you sow, so shall you reap. What you do will come back to you!' It is the Law of Action and Reaction. This law seems to have been created by the Creator of this universe. Just like there is the Law of Gravity that states that everything gets pulled to the centre of the earth due to a force called Gravity, the Law of Karma governs everything unfolding on the planet. There are many Universal Laws. The Law of Cycles ensures that the earth rotates precisely, once in 24 hours, the cycle of seasons and the revolution of the earth around the sun, are all a part of the several Universal Laws that govern our planet.

One of the most important Universal Laws is the Law of Karma. Every Karma or action of a conscious human being is recorded in his Karmic account. Each of us has our own Karma. My Karma is different from your Karma. Many of us wonder if there is family Karma or community Karma or even

Karma of a city or country. There is no such thing! Every individual human being is responsible for their action. This action, good or bad is recorded by the Law of Karma. Then, Karma rewards us or redeems our bad deeds, appropriately. That is why, the Law of Karma is known as the Law of Action and Reaction. It means that every action will initiate an equivalent reaction.

The Law of Karma is based on the principle of cause and effect. Our action becomes the cause and this cause will result in an effect. Good actions will be the cause of a good reaction or a good effect and bad actions will become seeds that will sprout as a bad destiny. Neutral actions will result in neutral reactions and therefore, they are not recorded by Karma. Let us not imagine that any of our actions done behind closed doors can escape the purview of Karma. The Karmic monitor is within each one of us. It is more powerful than any video camera or audio recorder. It will capture every action and will ensure that we redeem the same.


The Law of Karma is unique. Not only does it apply during our lifetime but it is also responsible for our death, just as it controls our birth. Did you choose how you came to earth? No, it was Karma. Thereafter, everything that is unfolding in our life is unfolding as per Karma, our past actions. Even our death is controlled by Karma. When we die, our Karma doesn't get finished. We carry forward our Karma into a new life. Therefore, we cannot escape Karma even after we die. Until we realize the A to Z of Karma, we will never realize the truth of how it works.

Just like any Universal Law, the Law of Karma is perfect. Have we ever seen the earth suddenly rotate in the opposite direction? Do we doubt that our tables and chairs will suddenly start flying in the sky? The world is governed by perfect Universal Laws and one such law is the Law of Karma. Therefore, we must not make any mistake in understanding this law, accepting it and living our life following the principles of the Law of Karma.

How many people actually understand the A to Z of the Law of Karma? Many around the globe today, accept Karma. Whenever something happens, they say, 'It is Karma.' Many people have realized that it is not luck, chance or serendipity that makes things happen. It is the Law of Karma in action. There are still a few who believe in luck and astrology and even go to magicians, tarot readers and voodoo experts. These people have not realized that there is nothing like luck. It is all pluck. We will pluck our destiny depending on the deeds we plant, just as we pluck fruits depending on the seeds we plant. Have you ever seen apples growing on a mango tree? It is impossible. The Universal Law will not permit it. So, the Law of Karma is the law of the earth, we must accept it, respect it and live by it.

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Just like the Seeds we plant decide the Fruit on the Tree, The Law of Karma ensures, our Deeds decide our Destiny!



Have you ever wondered, why there are no pineapples on an apple tree? No, because you know very well that the fruit on a tree depends on the seed. Why then, do we question when something happens in our life? We question because we don't realize that whatever is unfolding in our life is depending on our deeds. Nothing is happening by chance. There is no good luck and bad luck. Just like strawberries grow not by luck but by the seed that we planted, our life is also unfolding moment by moment, based on our actions recorded by the Law of Karma.

Did you choose your parents? Did you choose your gender or your nationality? Who decided your birth and how you came to earth? Everything is due to the Law of Karma. Our parents had no control over choosing us nor could we choose our parents. The circumstances of our birth were decided by Karma. It is our Karma that is carried forward, life after life. It is Karma that decides our new journey on the planet.

The Law of Karma seems to have several clear principles with which it governs everything. If something bad is happening to a seemingly good person, it only means that this good person has some Karmic debt, some negative Karma in his account. We need not doubt this because the Law of Karma is a Law of Action and Reaction. Unless there is an action, there cannot be a reaction. Therefore, what is unfolding in anybody's life is the result of their past action. Such is the Law of Karma.

What happens to our Karma when we die? Every 'body' dies, but don't we say, 'He passed away?' Who passed away? The one who was alive, left the body. We are so sure that the

deceased has departed that we cremate or bury the body. If we are ME, the Mind and Ego that departs at death, we will carry our unsettled Karma, good or bad into our next birth on earth. That is why, sometimes, a child is born blind. It is not because God is not kind. It is because everything is controlled by Karma. Everything happening in our life is happening according to the good or bad that we have done, in the past.

How does our bank account work? Suppose, we have several credit cards and we keep spending. We are creating debits but ultimately, it will wipe away our credit balance, our cash or deposits. Now, we have to deposit more cash to use. Just like there are debits and credits in a bank, there are debits and credits in our life. The only difference is that everything unfolding in life depends on our Karmic balance. Life is Karma. Without Karma, there is no life. Everybody alive is doing Karma, just as everybody alive is receiving the fruits of their past Karma in the form of whatever unfolds in their life.


Nobody can define exactly, how the Law of Karma works. We can only infer it depending on what we see. It is just like the Law of Gravity. We believe gravity exists because if there was no gravity, things would be flying in the sky. Therefore, we accept that due to the force of gravity, our feet are on the street. So also, those who understand the Law of Karma through inference, realize the principles behind this law. If there was no such law, then, there would be apples on mango trees. The Universal Principle makes us realize that whatever you do, will come back to you. The Law of Karma is like a boomerang with the principle, 'What goes around, comes around!'

The Law of Karma is automatic, like any other Universal Law. It needs no intervention. It controls our death, our birth and how we will return to earth. Nobody can escape this law but those rare few who understand the A to Z of Karma may be able to transcend Karma and be liberated, not just from the Karma that unfolds on earth but also from rebirth. For this, one needs Enlightenment, and this is not common. 99% of us just live, do our Karma and die. Based on our actions, good or bad, the Law of Karma will either reward us or punish us, respectively.

Will you ever wonder why there are thorns growing in your garden? You wouldn't because you would know for sure that it was some seed that was planted. Why, then, do we wonder when bad things unfold in our life? Why do we presume that others are experiencing good luck? It is only because we have not understood the Law of Karma and how it works. Nothing can happen in this world escaping the jurisdiction of Karma. Everything unfolding in our life is our own Karma, our own action. Let us not have any doubt about the Law of Karma.

As long as man is alive, he must act. When we are kids, we are innocent and our actions, although Karma, are not recorded by the Law of Karma. This is because we have not developed a mature mind and intellect to discriminate and act. But once we grow up, every action, good or bad is recorded by Karma, the Law

Can a man live without action? No, it is impossible! For a man to be alive, grow and live, he must act. In the first quarter of our life, we learn. In the second quarter, we earn. We seek a livelihood, a profession or an occupation and this makes us interact with the world. As we interact, we are in action, all the time. These actions may be good or bad. Every good action becomes the seed of a reward, just as every bad action will be redeemed by something equally bad. Most of us are aware of both the facts - we can't escape action and we can't escape from the reaction of that action. Therefore, some of us wonder, if there is a way to escape action.

Can a person escape from action? No, he cannot! A man has to perform action. Therefore, all cultures, religions and societies teach us to live ethical and moral lives. If there was no Karma, then, there was no need to be good. We could be thieves who would cheat, murder or commit other crimes and seek worldly pleasures. So, what stops us from committing these sins? Aren't we warned as kids that we will burn in hell for our wrongdoings? But is it actually true that we will go to hell and suffer? No! The truth is that we will experience both, heaven and hell when we take birth on earth. Heaven and hell are controlled by Karma and all depend on our actions. This is the truth.

Because man cannot escape from action, he tries to perform good action. He tries to live as a kind and compassionate being. Not only does he try to do as many good deeds as he can, to as many people as he can and as often as he can but he also stops himself from doing bad things or sins. Man is conscious that his actions or his deeds will become seeds of his destiny. However, not everybody realizes that we are the masters of our destiny, that there is nothing like luck, rather, our own unavoidable actions that are unfolding and seeming to be our good or bad luck.

Man does not try to evade action because he realizes that it is not possible. You may be in action for a short period of time but you can't live without action, for long. Therefore, it is a must for us to do good Karma. There was a rich businessman who decided that he would renounce the world because he wanted to be free from Karma. He wanted to be liberated from all actions and corresponding reactions. So, he gave up everything and went into the forest. He carried very few clothes as he went to live in meditation and seclusion. One day, he noticed that his pants were getting shorter. Soon, he caught the culprit. It was a rat! To get rid of the rat, he got a cat and thus, solved the problem of the rat eating his clothes away but the cat needed milk. So, he arranged for a cow. After a few days, he grew tired of milking the cow. So, he went to the nearby village and got a woman to milk the cow. Living with the woman, he was blessed with a child and his secluded home was once again full of Karma as he started living a new family life.

What can a human being do? He has no option. He has to live, love, eat, drink, walk and talk. Otherwise, he will die. Man

cannot survive without action and the irony is that his action will have a reaction.

Therefore, it is due to our ignorance that we think that there is a distant God, somewhere up in the skies who controls our destiny. It is nothing but our own Karma, the Law of Action and Reaction that is causing things to unfold in our life. But we, human beings are blessed to choose. We cannot control what is happening in our life but we have the right to choose our action. If we do not use our intelligence to discriminate and choose, then we are creating trouble for ourselves. Therefore, we must be conscious about our actions. We must control our actions and thereby, control our destiny. Not just that, we must also understand the Law of Karma. The action of realizing the truth about Karma will reveal to us, a way to be free from Karma, free from suffering and free from rebirth on earth. So, instead of letting our Karma tie us to this material world, we must realize who is actually doing this Karma, why is Karma being done and ultimately, find a way to transcend Karma.

EVERY ACTION HAS A REACTION

What is controlling our life? There are some actions that we control. We have the privilege to choose and to act. But are we controlling other people's actions? Somebody is good to us, while somebody else is rude and bad. We sometimes wonder, 'Why?' We did not wrong them in any way. We don't realize that whatever bad is happening in our life is a reaction of our past deeds.

If we look at a garden with several fruit trees, we will find apple trees, mango trees and coconut trees. But do we ever find apples growing on mango trees or mangoes on coconut trees? We will say, 'It is impossible!' Why? Because nature will not permit it. What is this nature and who is stopping apples from growing on a mango tree? It is the Universal Law of Action and Reaction, the Law of Karma. It is the Law of Cause and Effect. Because we have planted apples, we will find apples on the tree and so, if we see coconuts and not jackfruits, it is neither our luck nor is it God's Will that is causing this. It is our Karma.

As per the Law, every action will have a reaction. As you sow, so shall you reap. Therefore, what you do, is sure to come back to you. If you don't want evil returning to you, don't do evil, just as if you don't do good, then you are depriving yourself of good reactions that you would like to unfold in your life. Everything that is happening in our life is happening because of Karma. Either it is our past Karma, our past actions that are unfolding or it is our present Karma that is the result of our own conscious choices.

Nothing happens by luck or chance. Somehow the world believes a lot in luck and therefore, the businesses of astrology and palmistry thrive. Don't we look up at the stars and wonder, 'What do the stars have in store for us?' Because we do not understand the simple Law of Karma, we submit ourselves to the horoscopes that tell us that our life is unfolding depending on the date and time of our birth and the position of our stars, thinking them to be true. Everything is unfolding as per Karma and not as per the wish of the stars. How many of us believe in Zodiac signs? Instead of taking accountability for our actions, we blame our Zodiac sign and when things don't happen the way they should, we conclude that it is because of the Zodiac sign of others. Little do we realize that everything that is unfolding in our life is nothing but Karma. We look at the stars in the sky and we foretell their position and their trajectory in space. But these have nothing to do with what is unfolding in our life. What is happening in your life and my life is the direct result of Karma. It is either our current actions that are causing reactions in our life or it is our past actions, actions unknown to us that are unfolding as our destiny. Those who do not understand the Law of Karma and don't believe in the governance of the universe being controlled by Karma, meekly submit their life to luck and serendipity. We ignorantly believe that things are happening by chance when in reality, it is all happening by our choice.

What would you do if you were walking through the woods and you reach a point, where there is a river? You have no choice but to return. Else, how would you cross the river? Like many, would you sit in prayer to go across the river? How would prayer help? You

have to act, don't you? If the river is shallow, you have to walk across. If it is deep, you have to swim. And if you don't know how to swim, then you have to find a raft or a boat. Crossing the river needs action. Just sitting and praying will not solve the problem. Because many of us depend too much on prayer, we underestimate the importance of Karma. No doubt, prayer itself is a good action and works after we have tried our best and finally, reach out to the Divine for intervention but if we do not do our Karma, then, even prayers won't work. So, do your best and leave the rest, to the Divine.

Let us know, beyond doubt that just as every seed will sprout, every action will result in a reaction. We don't know when and we don't know for what but some or the other time, our action will be redeemed with a reaction. So also, everything that is happening is nothing but a redemption of a past action. The universe is an organized place and everything is governed by the Universal Laws. Nothing in this world happens as random acts nor does a distant God in the sky micromanage whatever unfolds on earth. Everything that is happening is a reaction to an action.



While we are in Complete Control of our Action, Once that is Performed, we have no control over its Reaction! WHY DO BAD THINGS HAPPEN TO GOOD PEOPLE?

Have you ever wondered, 'Why do good people suffer? Why do bad things happen to good people? Is God so weak and feeble?' All these questions arise due to our ignorance. These are not true. Bad things cannot happen to good people, just as apples cannot grow on mango trees. Such is the Universal Law. The law states, 'As you sow, so shall you reap.' Therefore, if bad things are happening, there is no other option but to believe that bad actions or Karma have been performed.

Sometimes, we wonder, 'How is this possible?' We know somebody dear to us has never done anything cruel to anybody and has never been unkind. They have always been loving, caring, compassionate and helpful to others. Still, so many miseries befall them. They are enveloped in misfortune, ill health and poverty. It seems that God is unkind or not powerful but this is not the case. The fact is that whatever is unfolding, may be a result of past actions or actions done, long ago, which have either been forgotten or the actions of a previous life that were not settled. If bad things are happening, they are because of bad deeds or bad Karma. There is no other possibility.

Sometimes, the opposite happens. We find people who knowingly cause harm to others, being blessed with good luck. Everything that they touch, seems to turn into gold. We consider them to be lucky and start cursing our luck. We know, for sure, that they have done nothing worthy to deserve this fortune and success. What we don't know, is their past Karma. What unfolds as their good fortune is a result of their past deeds. Once that is over, reactions to their present actions will start unfolding. Such is the Law of Karma. If good

things are happening, they are only because of good deeds and if bad things are happening, there is no other reason apart from bad Karma.

There was a religious leader who had spent his entire life praying to God. One day, his young teenage daughter was diagnosed with cancer. She suffered a lot and ultimately, died. He cried bitterly in his prayers. He used to be devoted to his God but then he wondered, 'Whether this disease and the death of his daughter was a result of God's cruelty, or was it just that God was not powerful enough?' He concluded that God was kind but probably not powerful enough to control the disease and death of the daughter of somebody who had spent his entire life in devotion and prayer. Alas! If only the one who was so devoted to God realized the truth about the Law of Karma, he would have accepted the unfolding without protest. He would have surrendered to the Law of Karma knowing that even God does not interfere with the Universal Laws that God has created. Sure, prayers are a positive Karma and can cause a reaction nothing less than a miracle but the ways of Karma and how Karma unfolds will remain unknown to man.

The next time you see something going wrong in somebody's life, don't wonder, 'Why?' Just as if you find a possible threat waiting to unfold, don't just hope that it doesn't. What you can do is just do your best. After doing your best, you must learn to accept without protest and surrender the rest to Karma. We have no other choice.

Bad things can't happen to good people just as good things can't happen to bad people. Let us be clear about this beyond doubt. In fact, there are no good or bad people. There are just 'people', who do good and bad Karma. Good actions will be rewarded and sins will be punished. Unfortunately, because we believe in the fairy tale of heaven and hell, that we will go there after we die, come face to face with God, be judged and finally be rewarded or punished for our deeds, we do not realize that heaven and hell are not some distant locations, somewhere far away but they are right here, on earth. It is our birth and every rebirth on earth that makes us experience heaven or hell because of our good deeds or sins. Everything is controlled by Karma. Life is Karma.

If we really want to make the best of our life, we must align ourselves to understanding how Karma works. We must accept this Universal Law of Action and Reaction. We must learn how this Law operates the three accounts of Karma and how they influence our birth on this earth. Does our Karma, our actions, just disappear in the sky? No! Our Karmic Account plays a part and we return to earth in a rebirth in a new body and with our unsettled Karma. That is why, one child is born blind and other is born in fortune circumstances with all comforts. Everything is controlled by Karma. Let us know more about the three accounts of Karma.

Prarabdha Karma, Our opening Balance



Karma has 3 accounts. The first is *Prarabdha* Karma. It is the opening balance of our Karmic Account. The second is *Agami* Karma or the current account that accumulates the actions done in the present birth. The third account is *Sanchita* Karma, which is the corpus or the warehouse of our Karma. Let us first understand *Prarabdha* Karma.

Did you decide your birth? Did you decide how you came to earth? Did you decide your parents, gender or nationality? No! Then, who chose it all? It is Karma. Our past Karma doesn't disappear into nothingness. It becomes the seed that is planted for our future. Nothing happens by chance nor is there some distant God in a far-away heaven deciding our birth. It is our *Prarabdha* Karma or our opening balance that brings us to earth in a birth.

What does *Prarabdha* Karma do? Everything that is happening in life is happening as per *Prarabdha* Karma. We, sometimes wonder, 'Why good things are happening to bad people or the other way round, 'Why bad things are happening to good people.' Good things and bad things are not happening because people are good or bad. Things happen the way they do because our past Karma is being settled. All our past Karma remains as Karmic debt in our Karmic account. Then, we are born with a bunch of Karma as the opening balance or *Prarabdha* Karma. This may be good or bad but this must be redeemed. Therefore, this unfolds in our life as our circumstances. As our *Prarabdha* Karma, the opening balance of Karma that we start our life with gets redeemed, it will not be repeated. For instance, I may have a hundred positive and a hundred negative Karma in my opening balance. I have to settle the score. I have no option

but to face this Karma which I have carried into the world. Yes, I can choose to do good Karma and settle some of this but if I don't, then the opening balance will continue throughout my life till the score is settled. Karma makes no mistake. Things don't happen by chance. Everything is happening as per Karma. Either it is our *Prarabdha* Karma, the opening balance or *Agami* Karma, our present Karma that is causing things to unfold in our life. *It is Karma that is in charge of the drama, the earth-show, in which we come and go*.

Many people wonder, 'Why is some child born blind?' Is it because God is not kind? Of course not! It is due to Karma. Destiny or chance is nothing but Karma and it starts with our opening balance, *Prarabdha* Karma, in every lifetime. In the end, the closing balance gets carried forward into our warehouse or corpus of Karma called *Sanchita* Karma.

Is there any way that we can be free from *Prarabdha* Karma? Yes, we can be free if only we realize that Karma doesn't belong to us and it is our ignorance that is causing us to return to earth in a rebirth with our Karma. Then, we can be liberated from our *Prarabdha* Karma and in fact, from all Karma and thereby, liberated from rebirth on earth.

Most people live and die and they don't realize, 'Who am I?' Therefore, they carry Karma as the Mind and Ego, ME. When the body dies, Karma remains. It is unsettled Karma that ultimately leads to the circumstances of our birth — how we will be born and this will go on and on. Our goal is to be free from returning to earth and not carrying Karma into another birth because if we come to earth, we are sure to suffer, even if

we may have a lot of good Karma. Anybody who is born on earth must suffer and therefore, the goal of human life is to attain Liberation.

People wonder, 'Are we like puppets? If everything is happening as per *Prarabdha* Karma or our opening balance and everything is predestined, then isn't life hopeless?' This is a misunderstanding. While we are born with an opening balance of Karma, we are also given a Free Will to choose. Only human beings are blessed with an intellect to discriminate. Let me make you understand this, in simple terms. Suppose, you are driving a car. The car is in your control and you can go fast or slow, turn left or right, go ahead or reverse. This is your free will or your present Karma. This is not your *Prarabdha* Karma or the opening balance. However, you can't change the road. The road is already laid. This is like your past Karma, which cannot be changed. The road ahead is because of the *Prarabdha* Karma, the opening balance which is nothing but our past Karma unfolding in our life.

Therefore, we must be very careful of what Karma we do because every Karma gets recorded and every Karma must be redeemed, whether it is good or bad. We can't escape from Karma. It will return to us. If not in this birth then in a rebirth.

AGAMI KARMA, OUR CURRENT ACCOUNT



The second account of Karma is called *Agami* Karma or the current account. Everything that we are doing in life, our present actions are recorded in this account of Karma. Whatever is unfolding as our life is because of *Prarabdha* Karma or the opening balance, over which we have no control but we have complete control on our present Karma, the *Agami* or the current account of Karma.

Only a human being is blessed with *Agami* Karma. Only a human being can create Karma out of choice. He is a *Karta* or the 'doer' of action or Karma. All other living creatures are understood to be only 'experiencers' or *Bhoktas*. They come to suffer their past Karma. They don't create new Karma. New Karma is created, only by human beings. We are blessed with an intellect with which we can choose our actions as we discriminate right from wrong. Once we perform any Karma, it gets recorded in our Karmic account. Our present Karma is recorded in the same account as our opening balance. In fact, our *Prarabdha* and *Agami* Karma, the opening balance and current account, merge to become one account, just like in a bank. Then, everything that unfolds as life is due to the unsettled Karma that we brought to earth, as well as all the Karma that we have done in the present birth.

Through *Agami* Karma, our current account of actions, we can nullify some of our opening balance, our past Karma that we bring as *Prarabdha* into this world. Suppose, I am carrying hundreds of negative Karma as my Karmic debt. By doing good Karma in my present life, I can create positive *Agami* Karma that can nullify or redeem my *Prarabdha* Karma or the

opening balance. The opposite may also be true. I may have some amazing positive Karma when I am born but if my present Karma, the *Agami* is full of sin, then I will be diluting and losing the rewards of my *Prarabdha* Karma that I brought in this birth, to earth. Therefore, *Agami* Karma, our present Karma or the current account is the most important Karma of all. This Karma is an opportunity in our hands. We cannot change our past Karma that we bring as our opening balance but we have been given an opportunity to choose our present Karma and by doing so, create a destiny of our choice. If we don't do good Karma then our destiny will unfold as per our past deeds, just as the seeds that were planted in the past will unfold as fruits on the trees.

We have a choice. We can choose our actions. Every action is a Karma. We can choose good Karma or bad Karma but whatever be the action, so will be the reaction. Good or bad, all actions will be recorded and ultimately when the body dies, these Karma will be recorded and we will return in a rebirth, based on our Karma. Very few amongst us are blessed to walk the path to Enlightenment, our very purpose. If we attain Enlightenment, then not only will we be free from all Karma on earth, our *Agami* or present Karma and *Prarabdha* or opening balance, but we will also be free from *Sanchita* Karma, the corpus or warehouse of cumulative Karma. Once we are free from all Karma, we don't have to return to earth in a rebirth. But this depends on our present Karma or the *Agami* Karma.

Most of us just live and die. We let our *Prarabdha* or opening balance of Karma unfold as circumstances. Then, we do fresh

Karma in our current account or *Agami*. We experience both pleasure and pain because of good Karma and bad Karma. Then, we die. But only the body dies. The ME, Mind and Ego, that is the director of all actions, all Karma, carries forward all the unsettled Karma into our next birth on earth. The unsettled Karma of *Agami*, our current account that merges with *Prarabdha*, our opening balance is tabulated and the Karma that is not redeemed in this lifetime will be added into our corpus or warehouse, *Sanchita* Karma.

When we hear of somebody like the Buddha, the Awakened One, what happened to them when it comes to their Karma? They were born as per their *Prarabdha* Karma, the opening balance. Thereafter, they chose their present Karma and it became a good *Agami* or current account. Their actions were focused on the Realization of the truth. They realized that they were not the body that was doing Karma. They were not even the Mind and Ego, ME, that was carrying Karma into a rebirth on earth. They realized the truth that they were nothing but the Divine Soul. It was this present Karma that liberated them to be free from all Karma.

SANCHITA KARMA, OUR CORPUS OR WAREHOUSE



We have discussed two types of Karma. *Prarabdha* Karma, our opening balance and *Agami* Karma, our current account. There is a third account as well. It is known as *Sanchita* Karma. It is the account that is our warehouse or corpus, where we carry forward all the unsettled Karma from each life.

When a man dies, he has some Karma that is unsettled. It may be good or bad. He started with an opening balance and he had a current account but everything is not settled in the moment of death. Death is sudden and there is always unsettled Karma that gets carried forward into our corpus or warehouse. This corpus is called our *Sanchita* Karma.

Sanchita Karma is the Karma that we carry forward, life after life. From this, a part is used as *Prarabdha* Karma or the opening balance for one life. As long as there is *Sanchita* Karma, we have no option but to return to earth in a rebirth. Only the one who is liberated from all Karma can escape this cycle of rebirth and not return to earth.

It seems that every living creature is born with a *Prarabdha* Karma which comes from their *Sanchita* Karma. Every living creature carries a warehouse. Then they are born only to consume some of their Karma. Since they do not create new Karma, they live, consume their Karma and die. They need to continue doing this until they are born as a human being. It is only a human being who can create new Karma and even wipe out *Sanchita* Karma or the cumulative Karma of all lifetimes.

While there is no documented proof of this, it is like our acceptance of gravity. It is proved by inference. One who is blessed to understand Karma and realize the truth of these three accounts will try to get liberated from Karma and all the suffering that we experience on earth, in a rebirth. As long as we are ignorant, we will live as the Mind and Ego, ME and when the body dies, we will carry forward our Karma into *Sanchita* Karma and then return in another life because of *Prarabdha* Karma or the opening balance.

So, what decides whether we will be born as a human being or an animal? It is our Sanchita Karma. While many people do not want to accept this, it seems to be true because Sanchita Karma or the warehouse of Karma decides our birth. How we come to earth is neither decided by our parents nor by God. It is all governed by the Law of Karma. If there was no Sanchita Karma or warehouse, two things would happen. One, somebody who lives a horrific life, killing many and performing crime after crime, would not be able to carry forward such a large negative debt into a new life. He would need many lives to settle such horrible Karma. Such a big and vast Karmic debt is deposited in Sanchita Karma. It may take many lives to clear this. The other thing that could happen is, when living creatures other than human beings, finish their life by consuming some of their past Karma, they would return to their Sanchita Karma to settle what is in their warehouse or corpus. Therefore, it is believed that there are three accounts. Otherwise, some people prefer to believe that there are just two accounts of Karma. We live, we die and the balance is carried forward into the next life.

The experts or the masters of Karma have submitted that there must be three accounts for the Law of Karma to unfold. Without three accounts it doesn't seem logical as to how Karma governs all actions and reactions.

Some people wonder that if there was such a warehouse of Karma, a corpus of several lifetimes, then how could one settle this or get rid of it? There is hope for this. It is called Enlightenment. When we realize the truth that Sanchita Karma doesn't actually belong to us, then in one moment we can be liberated from all Karma and from this continuous cycle of death and rebirth. But if we don't realize the truth about Karma, about who does Karma and who carries it forward, we will continue to suffer. Even if our Sanchita Karma or our warehouse is full of positive Karma, the moment we come to earth as a body, mind and ego, we have no option but to suffer the pain of the body, misery of the mind and agony of the ego. This is called the Triple Suffering. The only way to be free from misery on earth and from rebirth is to be free from all three accounts of Karma and this, certainly is possible.

THE KARMA CYCLE GOES ON AND ON...



Now that we have understood the three accounts of Karma, the question that people do not have an answer to is, 'How can we be free from these three accounts of Karma?' We are born with an opening balance and nobody can escape Karma. So, we will create fresh Karma in this life. And death is certain. We will die and our Karma will be carried forward to our corpus or warehouse, *Sanchita* Karma. Will this cycle of Karma go on and on? Yes, Karma is a cycle. It will go on and on. Only the body dies but the Mind and Ego, ME, will carry Karma and be reborn. It doesn't matter whether it is good Karma or bad Karma. As long as there is an action, there will be a reaction. As long as there is cause, the effect must come. Every act, as we understand, becomes a seed and so every deed will bear fruit.

Whatever is happening in life is all Karma. It is neither luck nor chance nor is it God's will. We often see people considering life to be all about fate and destiny. Why is it so? It is because they don't understand Karma. Everything unfolding in our life, is a result of Karma. First, it is our past Karma that appears as our destiny and then, it is our present Karma that bears fruit in our life. And this will not stop. There are many who believe that the Karmic cycle gets over in the moment of death. They think that there is no Karmic debt that is carried forward life after life. But then, how is our birth decided? While we will get into this in detail, we must understand that the three accounts of Karma are interconnected and work like a cycle.

Every act of ours, good or bad, is recorded in our Karmic account. Sometimes, it may not bear fruit for several years or

even several lifetimes but the Law of Karma makes no mistake. We will pay for what we have done or for that matter, even be rewarded. That is why, sometimes, we wonder as to why bad things are happening to good people. This is not true. It is all Karma unfolding. It may be some old Karma that had been left unsettled in our Karmic account that is being redeemed at the moment.

So, what must we do, when something bad happens? It may sound strange but we must rejoice because that Karma, which was in our account, is now settled. We have redeemed our Karmic debt. If it was not so, then, we would have that pending in our Karmic account and it could hit at us, anytime. Therefore, those who understand Karma and its three accounts, learn to accept without protest. They realize that it is their own past actions that are appearing as a reaction and causing both, pleasant and unpleasant circumstances. While we have no control on our destiny that is unfolding based on our past actions, we have complete control on our present actions, our present Karma. We have an intellect that can discriminate and we have a willpower that can choose. Every action that we choose becomes a Karma, which may either bear fruit in this life or in a future life. Nobody has any control on when the fruit will appear but we can be sure of one thing. Every seed will bear fruit and every deed will appear as our destiny and this will go on and on. Whatever Karma is redeemed in life, is settled. Whatever Karma remains unsettled in this life, will be carried forward and return to earth in a rebirth.

There was once a young man who lived with his uncle in a farm. He had no parents and his uncle's family was his family. He had grown up in the village and used to help his uncle. One day, he had an opportunity to go work in the city. His uncle wished him good luck and told him to do a final task before he left to start his new career. The farmer, the uncle wanted to plant a special variety of trees to create a boundary wall around the farm and he gave this young man, the task of planting seeds in a row along the periphery of the farm. As the boy was planting the seeds, his friends came and told him, 'Let's go for a movie.' He said that he could not because he had to finish this task. Then, one of his friends suggested, 'Just dump the pending seeds in a pit. How will your uncle know? Then, we can go and have fun.' The young man got carried away by the words of his friend and decided to follow his advice. He quickly dug a deep pit and put all the left-over seeds and covered it with the soil. A couple of years later, the boy returned to the village to see his uncle. As the two were talking and walking around the farm, he noticed the beautiful row of trees that bordered their farm. But as they kept walking, they saw a jungle of trees. The boy started to cry. He recalled how he had dumped all the seeds, there. Now, they had grown into trees in a haphazard manner. Nobody can escape Karma. Even if we die, our Karma will return whether good or bad. We cannot escape from the deeds that we have done. We must not underestimate the power of Karma.

11 WHO DECIDED YOUR BIRTH?



Did you decide your birth? Did you decide how you came to earth? Did you decide your parents, your siblings, your gender and your nationality? No, you did not decide or choose any of these. It was all decided by Karma.

We pay scant attention to the truth that our birth is a result of our Karma. Somebody is born poor and somebody is born rich. This is not luck pressing the switch. If we are born blind, it is not because God is unkind. It is because of Karma. We don't realize the simple truth that every action of ours is recorded by the Law of Action and Reaction. The action must be settled. It must be redeemed. If we have a bank account and we have taken a loan, we cannot ignore our debt and try opening a fresh account to escape paying back the loan. The banking computer will track us down even if we go to a new city because our ID is recorded and all our transactions are accounted. Similarly, Karma tabulates the good and the bad that we do and cumulatively, causes our birth.

Does our present Karma directly decide our birth? If we have understood correctly, then the present Karma, at the end of this life merges with the corpus or warehouse of carried forward Karma. It is from that corpus, *Sanchita* Karma, that our *Prarabdha* Karma or our opening balance for life is decided when we come to earth in a birth.

Not only does Karma decide our birth but our *Prarabdha* Karma is our opening balance that shapes our life. A child could be living in a slum and we may wonder what wrong the child has done to suffer in poverty. It may be a right

observation that the child has done no harm but what about the one who has been born as the child? The body is formed in the womb of our mother. The body is just an instrument of Karma. It only appears to suffer, just as it appears to be rewarded. The truth is that the Karma belongs to the Mind and Ego, ME, that is born as this little baby. The suffering maybe experienced by the body but in reality, the one who is suffering is ME.

Until the time that we develop a mind and intellect, everything that is unfolding in our life is a result of our *Prarabdha*, our opening balance of Karma. A child may die at a very young age and we may wonder, 'How can God be so cruel?' This is only because we are ignorant about Karma. God is not micromanaging the destiny of 8 billion people. Everything is being controlled by Karma. As we grow, we have the privilege of choosing our actions and these actions get added to our *Prarabdha* Karma and unfold as our destiny.

While we have a control on our present actions, do we have a control over our past deeds? No! Those deeds are already done and they have already been recorded by Karma. Not only have they caused our birth and our destiny till date but they will also continue to unfold as our Karma because these actions are done and cannot be reversed.

When we look at life unfolding from a Karmic perspective, we realize that the whole world is controlled by Karma. Even a dog that is suffering, seems to be the result of Karma. All suffering in this world is Karmic. A tree is bound to the ground

but it is alive. Every living creature has feelings. It seems that every living organism is born to settle the score of past Karma. Through inference, this seems to be the only logic.

Many people do not want to accept this doctrine and they choose to live ignoring this but the fact is that we can't escape Karma. Even in the moment of death, our unsettled Karma is carried forward. If we live unethical lives that are filled with immoral deeds, we will have an equivalent suffering in our new birth on earth. Nobody can explain or define this precisely but through inference we can realize that death is not the end. The body dies but the Karma is carried by the ME, the Mind and Ego into a new body, when we return in a rebirth.

We must learn to accept and live with Karma. Neither must we curse God nor must we attribute our birth to our parents. It is all Karma but because we don't understand this simple, yet profound law, we fervently pray, not realizing that even our prayers cannot overpower the effect of our past Karma. There is an old saying, '*Pray as if everything depends on God but work as if everything depends on man.*' Without good Karma, even prayers will not work. Everything is decided by Karma.

12 DOES KARMA BELONG TO THE BODY?

For most people, Karma belongs to the body. It is the body that acts. Is this true, in reality? The body is the instrument of action and no doubt, it performs the Karma but who is driving it to do the Karma? We are all controlled by our mind. The Mind and Ego, ME, is the creator of Karma and not the body. For instance, if I take a gun and shoot you, does the Karma belong to the gun? One would say that the gun is just an inanimate object and has no Karma. In this analogy, the gun is just the instrument. I used an instrument to act. If I direct you to do some Karma and you did not intend to do that Karma or you were forced to do it, then, the Karma doesn't belong to you but to me. Surely, if you had the choice to refuse to do that Karma and you still did it, then you will also be a part of the Karma.

Many of us are unclear as to whom the Karma belongs to. While it seems that it belongs to the body, we also attribute the Karma to the mind, ego, intellect and even the Soul. Very often, people consider Karma to belong to the Soul and thus, think that the Soul will be reborn. But the Soul doesn't carry any Karma. Then, what happens, exactly? Let us contemplate.

Who starts the Karmic journey? There is no body. It is just the Mind and Ego, ME, that is conceived in the first cell of our existence, the zygote. How does this happen? This happens when the Soul, the Spark Of Unique Life, gives life to the Mind and Ego, ME, to start a new journey on earth. Why does this new journey start? It is because the ME has unsettled Karma. It may be good or bad. As long as there is unsettled Karma, the ME has to return to earth in a rebirth, to settle the

Karmic debt. At death, the body dies. It returns to dust but all the Karma that it did, doesn't get wiped off. It is not over. If that was not the truth, then, there was no need to live a good, ethical or moral life. We could have just had fun, till life was done. Then, why don't we do this? Because we see the Law of Karma operating. First, on earth and then, at the point of rebirth. We see that a person is born in good or bad circumstances and we infer it is Karma. The new-born baby has not yet done any Karma. Then, why is it blind? It is because Karma belongs to ME, the Mind and Ego, that is born in the blind baby. When this blind baby grows up, who will drive its Karma? It is the mind along with the ego. One day, the blind baby will grow up and ultimately, die. It will experience Karma along with ME, but it doesn't own any Karma. When death occurs, the Mind and Ego, ME, will once again, carry Karma that is unsettled and return to earth in a rebirth. This cycle will go on and on and we will be reborn, until we are liberated from Karma. This will continue until we are free of the Mind and Ego, ME.

Not many people understand Karma completely. They curse God for whatever is happening, without realizing that it is all Karma. They wonder why an innocent child suffers because they don't realize that the body is just an instrument of action. Who is actually doing the Karma and who owns the Karma? This has remained a mystery in our history. Therefore, people believe the myth and we grow up with it. Because we think the body is creating the Karma and we see the body die, we think that the Karma is over. We don't realize that the Karma does not belong to the body. We don't contemplate as to who

is actually creating the Karma. Therefore, we are unable to be free from Karma and we not only suffer as the body, mind and ego on earth but we also return in a rebirth, only to suffer, again and again.

If one wants clarity about Karma, one must ponder, not just on Karma but also on death and birth. What exactly happens in the moment of death? Who dies? Why is somebody born? What role does Karma play in birth and rebirth? Who is actually creating Karma? Who is the owner of Karma?

The answer is very simple. Karma belongs to the Mind and Ego, ME, not to the body. In the moment of death, the body returns to dust and Karma that is unsettled, good or bad, is the cause for us to be reborn. Even though we read this many, many times but our mind will confuse us and stop us from realizing the truth because if we realize the truth, our mind will cease to exist. Therefore, along with the Ego, our Mind becomes ME and it drives action and creates Karma. The ME never dies. It carries Karma into another birth and this cycle goes on. Because of our ignorance, we are caught in this cycle and we continue to suffer, forever.

ACTIONS CREATE KARMA, NOT THOUGHTS



How often have you heard people say that they had an evil thought and that has caused so much bad Karma? Somehow, we believe that every time there is an evil thought, it gets recorded in our Karmic account and we suffer for every evil thought. But is this true?

Do we have control on our thoughts? Thoughts just pop up in our mind and while we cannot control thoughts from appearing, we can control our actions. Every thought need not become an action. We, human beings, are blessed with the intellect to discriminate. We are also blessed with willpower. We can choose to act or not to act. The moment we act, there is no doubt, that it creates Karma. Karma is action. But is thought also an action? No!

We must be absolutely clear that thoughts do not create action. For this, we must understand the mind. What is the mind? Have you seen the mind? Let us try to find the mind. Can you touch your nose? Can you pull your ears? Can you see your eyes in the mirror? Do you have any doubt about the existence of these sense organs? No, you don't. Now, what about your brain? Have you seen a scan of your brain? Have you seen an image of your heart or an X-ray of your bones? We all get an opportunity to see our body but have you ever seen the mind? No! Nobody has seen the mind. Then how can the mind create Karma? We must ultimately decode this mystery but for now, let us try to understand the mind.

The mind is nothing but a bundle of thoughts. It appears to exist when thoughts appear. When we are in a state of deep

dreamless sleep, we do not experience the presence of the mind but when we are awake, we feel that we have a mind. In reality, these are just thoughts. Together, the thoughts become the mind. The mind seems to be like a thought factory that can produce up to 50 thoughts a minute and these are the very thoughts that make us blind to the reality. These thoughts seem to create Karma. But there is a difference between the thoughts and the mind. When we try to still the mind, we can actually kill the mind. Then there is no mind but we will still have thoughts. How can we understand this?

When the mind is in command, we are caught in thought. Not just one but many thoughts. Our mind makes thoughts pour like rain and they push us down the drain. We create Karma through our actions and thus suffer again and again. Directly, thoughts do not create Karma but because our mind seems to be the director of thoughts and it bombards us with so many thoughts, we seem to live like puppets and let thoughts create actions without using the power of discrimination to choose what to do and what not to do. Somehow, our mind confuses us and creates a very unclear picture when it comes to Karma and who creates Karma.

So, let us be absolutely clear that Karma means action. Karma is action. Karma is not a thought. No doubt, the mind uses thoughts to create feelings and ultimately, actions but if we can use our intellect, which gets activated in the state of Consciousness, then, the thought will not become a Karma. We have to learn how to flip over from mind to Consciousness. Only then, will we be the master of our

thoughts and in control of our Karma and consequently, our destiny. For now, it is important to realize this truth that thoughts do not create Karma, only actions do. When thoughts become the mind, we can lose control and become a slave to our thoughts and mind. We may seem to be a slave to Karma itself because we have not activated our intellect that can control thoughts from becoming an action.

No man can escape from action and neither can we escape from thought. But we can escape from our mind. When thoughts don't pour like rain, rather, appear like gentle snowflakes, one by one, there is no mind, only gentle thoughts that enter our Consciousness. In this state, our intellect can discriminate and choose as to which thought should become action or Karma. Thoughts, by themselves, will not create Karma. But for this, we must still the mind. We must kill the mind. Otherwise, the mind will remain in charge and make us believe that through its thoughts, it will create Karma and we will remain a slave of the mind till we reach our grave.

HOW IS KARMA CARRIED FORWARD? To understand the A to Z of Karma, we must understand that Karma doesn't end in the moment of death. The body dies but ME, the Mind and Ego, returns to earth in a rebirth based on Karma. It may be good or bad Karma. That hardly matters. As long as there is pending unsettled Karma in our Karmic account, we have to return to earth.

The cycle of birth and rebirth is therefore, the method whereby, Karma is carried forward. Karma doesn't belong to the body. The body dies and returns to dust. The same body does not return again. Just like we cannot see videos and pictures being transferred from one mobile to another but we can access those images in a new mobile, similarly, a new-born child is full of past Karma and there is no other possibility than to infer that this is the carried forward Karma from a previous life.



Those who believe in the Law of Karma, often ask the most profound question, 'Can we be free from Karma? As long as man continues to live and perform action, he will create Karma. It maybe good Karma or bad Karma but we cannot escape from action. Then, how can we be free from Karma?

Our goal of life is *Moksha* or *Nirvana*. What is this? It is to be free from Karma. Some people call it Salvation or Liberation. Our goal is to escape from this continuous cycle of death and rebirth and suffering on earth. Only man has been blessed with the faculty of intellect through which, he can be free from Karma and thus, being liberated, can be united with the Divine.

One day, when Gokul asked his Guru, his Spiritual Master, whether good Karma was the way to Moksha, the Guru explained that as long as we have Karma, we can never attain Moksha. Every Karma that we perform, every deed, is like a seed that we are planting. Even if Gokul was doing great acts of service and charity, he was still planting seeds that would bind him to earth. His good Karma would make sure that he returns to earth in a rebirth to be rewarded for all the good deeds. Gokul was confused. He asked his Master, 'Are you telling me that doing good Karma is bad?' 'No', replied the Guru, 'We must do good Karma when it comes to choosing between doing good or bad. Serving others is good but our goal is to do it like a Karma Yogi. We must do it with the attitude that I am not the body, mind and ego. We must not expect any fruits or results from our actions or Karma. 



Our goal is *Mukti*. The purpose of a human being's existence is freedom, freedom from Karma. But the immediate response is, 'How can I be free from action?' No human being can be free from Karma.

Every 'body' must act. Whoever is born as a human being creates Karma. The other living creatures are only consuming their Karma. Human beings are *Kartas*. Others are *Bhoktas*. They seem to have come to earth only to settle their past deeds, their past Karma. Those who are not humans, do not create fresh Karma. For that matter, even a mentally challenged person who has no stable mind and intellect is no better than a *Bhokta* because such a person does not create any Karma. Other than this, all human beings who live are constantly creating Karma. Then, how can a human being achieve *Mukti* or freedom from Karma?

We can attain that state of *Mukti*, being liberated from Karma through what we call as Realization. When we realize that Karma is performed by the body and we are not the body, so, we are not doing the Karma. Who is directing the body to act? It is the ME, the Mind and Ego. But we are neither the mind, nor the ego. The mind and ego are subtle in their existence. They seem to exist but in reality, they are an illusion. They are a product of our ignorance. Because we do not realize that we are neither the body nor the mind and ego, we create Karma and suffer on earth, as well as, return in a rebirth.

When we are enlightened with the truth and when there is the Realization that we are not the body, mind and ego, we attain Mukti. What does this mean? It means that we are free from all Karma. Even though we are performing actions, we are not creating any fresh Karma because we have realized that we are not the body, mind and ego. We live as a Divine instrument and thus, none of the Karma done by us is recorded in our Karmic account. In fact, we don't even have a Karmic account anymore because we have realized our true identity. We are neither this body that acts nor the mind and ego that has the three accounts of Karma in its name. Not only are we free from Agami Karma, the current account or present Karma but we are also free from Prarabdha Karma, the opening balance and the accumulated corpus account, Sanchita Karma. We are Mukt. We are free. We are liberated.

When we were born, our birth was because of our *Prarabdha* Karma. It was the opening balance that we started this life with, as the body, mind and ego. However, on realizing that we are not the body, mind and ego, even our *Prarabdha* Karma or opening balance is wiped out. If our Realization is not complete, we will continue to experience some of our *Prarabdha* Karma, we will continue to redeem some of our past deeds but a realized being does not suffer from such Karma.

What about *Sanchita* Karma, the warehouse or the corpus of Karma that is carried forward life after life by the Mind and Ego, ME? When there is no mind and ego, when we have realized that we are the Divine Soul, where is the scope for *Sanchita* Karma to exist? All our past Karma, all our Karma that we carried forward through several past lives gets wiped

out in that moment of *Mukti*, in the moment of Realization of the truth. So, what next?

A person who attains *Mukti* is now free from all Karma. He is neither creating fresh Karma nor does have to redeem any past Karma. Such a person lives as a *Jivanmutka*, one who is liberated while alive. In the moment of death when the physical body dies and returns to dust, a *Jivanmukta* does not return to earth in a rebirth. A *Jivanmutka* has no Karma to settle. He attains *Moksha*. He is united with the Divine once he is liberated in the moment of the death of the physical body.

Every human being who lives has the goal of *Mukti*, the goal of realizing that we are not the body, mind and ego but the Soul. Every human being wants to be liberated from suffering but unfortunately whoever is born must suffer the triple suffering of the body, mind and ego despite their past Karma. *Mukti* liberates us from all suffering on earth and from rebirth. This is our ultimate goal, to realize that we are not the body, mind and ego but the Divine Soul.

MOKSHA, Liberation

What is *Moksha*? Is it the same as *Nirvana* or Salvation? Hindus believe that the goal of human existence is *Moksha*. The Buddhists believe that it is *Nirvana*, just as most of the Western world calls it Salvation. These are different names or terms but they have the same meaning. They all refer to Liberation from the cycle of death and rebirth and Unification with God.

Every religion advocates a philosophy and theology of what happens in the moment of death. Some scriptures tell us that we will go to a heaven or hell. Some say that we will be face-to-face with God on the day of judgement where all our past Karma will be reviewed and we will be rewarded or punished for our deeds, accordingly. There is hardly any religion that says that there is no Karma. Most religions advocate Karma but some consider heaven and hell not to be distant locations far away from the earth, rather, a state of being that we experience when we return in a rebirth.

Whatever be our religion and whatever be the term that our religion refers to, our ultimate goal is to be one with God. Our ultimate goal is to be free from Karma. Therefore, we must attain *Mukti*. Once we become a *Jivanmukta*, we have passed the first barrier. We have attained the state of Freedom or Liberation. Then, in the moment of death, not only are we liberated from all misery and free from all Karma but we are also free from the cycle of rebirth. We will not return to earth in a new body. We are liberated and united with the Divine.

There is a lot of confusion about what happens at death. Certain things are absolutely clear. A dead body does not create any fresh Karma. It is incapable of any action. The Soul has departed. The life energy that was giving us Power, is no more. Therefore, in the moment of death, there is no breath. There is no action. There is no Karma. We are so sure that the person has departed that we destroy the body of our near and dear ones after they die. Whether we cremate them or bury them, the body returns to dust. But what next?

As long as we live as the body, mind and ego and as long as I think that I am 'I', death is not the end. It is just a bend. The body will die but the Mind and Ego, ME, will carry its Karma, the unsettled actions, good and bad, to another life in another body. When we started our life, we started with an opening balance, *Prarabdha* Karma. As we lived, we created *Agami* Karma, the current account of present actions. During our lifetime, both *Prarabdha* and *Agami*, the opening balance and current account, together became responsible for the unfolding of our destiny. But once we realize the truth, we will be free from all Karma, from all the three accounts of Karma. Those who don't realize the truth are caught in the cycle of *Samsara*. They live, die and are reborn and this cycle goes on and on.


However, when we realize that we are not the body, mind and ego, it is a completely different scenario. If we attain *Mukti*, we become a *Jivanmukta*. Then, in the moment of death, we will not carry any Karma forward into a rebirth on earth. There will be no Karma. We would have attained freedom from all Karma. Thus, in the moment of death, we would be liberated from this cycle of Karma, of death and rebirth and

become one with the Divine. Those who realize the truth, realize that God is not God. God is SIP, the Supreme Immortal Power and we are not this body, mind and ego, we are the Divine Soul, a Spark Of Unique Life. In the moment of death, the Soul, which originates from SIP, returns to SIP, as the body returns to dust. This is *Moksha*, *Nirvana* or Salvation. What is Enlightenment? The word 'Enlightenment' means to bring in the light of Truth. Why should we bring in the light of truth? We should because we are enveloped in a blanket of ignorance. We live a life of darkness within ourselves. Although there is light in our outside world, there is darkness in our inner world and we cannot see the truth that is within. We need to realize that we are not the body that dies. This body was formed from the five elements – earth, water, air,

fire and space. It starts its journey as a single-celled zygote when the Power of life, the Soul or the Spirit creates fertilization. In that moment, we are conceived. Then, the cell multiplies from one to two, from two to four and so on, till it becomes about twenty-five billion cells and we arrive on earth. People call this our birth date. Is this really our 'birth' date? The truth is that we were conceived or born about nine months before. We all know this. It is a scientific truth but we don't realize it. We need Enlightenment. When we are born, we are a baby of about twenty-five billion cells. Then, we eat pizza, pasta, bread and rice. The body grows to about thirty trillion cells and one day, the body dies but we never die. We only leave the body. We depart in the moment of death. That is why, there is no breath. We are that Power of life that arrives on the day of conception or fertilization. We must realize this truth. We have the knowledge that we have learned in college but we don't have the Realization. This Realization is Enlightenment.

Enlightenment will lead us to a state of *Mukti* or Freedom, *Moksha* or Liberation. We need Enlightenment to overcome ignorance. Without Enlightenment, we will never be free from Karma. Without Enlightenment, we will believe in the lie, we will die and never discover, 'Who am 'I'?' We will live as the Body and the Mind and Ego, ME. We will try to do good deeds and create good Karma and this will only entangle us further in the Karmic cycle. The body will die and we will return to earth in a rebirth. We don't need to chase pleasure and achievement but we will realize this, only with Enlightenment. The only way to achieve the purpose of life is to overcome ignorance and be enlightened with the truth. This will not only liberate us from all suffering on earth but will also liberate us from our Karma and from the cycle of rebirth.

21 IMPORTANCE OF A GURU

To understand the A to Z of Karma, it is very important to have a Spiritual Master, a Mentor or a Guru. A Guru is one who takes us from Gu to Ru, that is, from darkness to light. As long as we try to understand Karma ourselves, we will use our mind. Our thoughts will lead to confusion and therefore, there will be no conclusion. A Guru is the wise one. He is himself enlightened, has overcome ignorance and is a master of Karma. He can lead us from understanding Karma to finally, transcending it.

There was a rich merchant who lived with a lot of faith in his Guru. He had assigned his Guru to be the executor of his Will. One day, the man died. His Will was read. He had divided his assets and one such division was the 19 camels that he possessed. He had written that half of it should go to his son, one-fourth should go to his daughter and one-fifth to his loyal servant. He had put a condition that they should not kill the camels. As the family was dividing his wealth, there was a conflict. How could the son take half of the camels because there were 19 of them? Half would mean 9 and a half. The daughter needed 1/4th or 4.75 camels and the servant had to take $1/5^{th}$, which is 3.8. They were unable to solve the problem. The Guru brought his camel and added it to the lot. He, now, asked the son to take half and the son took 10. He, then, asked the daughter to a quarter and she took 5 and the servant was happy to take 4, which was 1/5th or his share. Having resolved the conflict, the Guru walked away with his camel. The Guru is the wise one. Without the help of the Guru, we will remain in darkness, in ignorance and will suffer

Karma can be very confusing. What is this law? Who has created this law? How does it operate? What is the guarantee that the law exists to govern everything that is happening in the universe? If we cannot be free from action, then, how can we be free from Karma? Will we be caught in this cycle, forever? How is it possible for good Karma to not make us realize God? I too had all these questions and was confused about Karma. I had some vague idea that there was something called Karma. My common sense made me agree that the principle, 'As you sow, so shall you reap,' is a sensible principle under which Karma operates but I had so many questions about Karma that I needed the help of a Guru. I was blessed to meet Dada Vaswani, my Spiritual Mentor over 25 years back. Today, he is no more present in the physical plane on earth. Even though he has physically departed, his wisdom and guidance helped me understand Karma and go beyond it.

I used to ask my Guru, Dada, about Karma and how the three accounts of Karma operate. What is the guarantee that there are three accounts and not two? I could understand that our birth depended on our past Karma but what about *Sanchita* Karma, the warehouse or corpus of Karma? It was with the guidance of my Guru that I realized that all suffering on earth is because of Karma. God or SIP, the Supreme Immortal Power, is not a cruel person who is controlling all of us through a punitive law called Karma. My Guru explained that Karma is a reformative law and all living beings who are suffering on earth, other than man, are experiencing their Karma due to their own past deeds. They are not creating any

new Karma but when they finish this journey of life, all living creatures will return to their *Sanchita* Karma or warehouse. Ultimately, every living creature must return to earth in a human birth to be liberated from their Karma and be united with the Divine. Without the Guru, our mind can make us go round in circles and we can be caught in thoughts of ignorance. It is the Guru who helps us realize the truth.

My Guru helped me to go on a quest. He helped me seek the true purpose of life. It was because of my Guru that I evolved in my yearning for the Divine, for Eternal Happiness, for a purpose and reached the state of Self-Realization. I realized that I was not the body that was doing Karma. This body will perish. I was not the mind. My Guru used to joke with me. 'Let us find the mind,' he would say. There is no mind, yet, thoughts of the mind make us blind. With the guidance of my Master, I was able to let go of my ego, the false identity of 'me'. I realized that I am not 'I'. I became free from Karma as I started to live as a Divine instrument with my Mentor being my role model. His life, full of acceptance and surrender, helped me in getting liberation from Karma. If one wants to understand the A to Z of Karma, one needs the guidance of a Guru, a Spiritual Master.

To Understand Karma and Transcend it, we need a Master. The Guru will help us Attain Freedom from Karma, Faster.



WE ARE A DIVINE SOUL THAT HAS NO KARMA

Karma is a part of our day-to-day existence. Nobody can escape it. Karma is action and we live, breathe, walk, talk, eat, and meet people. We are constantly creating Karma. We have learned that there can be no freedom from Karma or action. Then, why are we struggling so much with Karma? Why are we trying to transcend it? 
we live as the body, mind and ego, we are caught in the cycle of Karma and rebirth. If we realize that we are the Divine Soul, what happens in the moment of death?



While you have complete control on your car, can you stop an accident from happening when a truck crashes into you? You did nothing wrong but still, a truck that had a brake failure, threw your bike off the road. Why did this happen? Obviously, it is your past Karma. You had

committed some wrong in the past equivalent to this crash. Now, it is redeemed. However, if you drive recklessly and crash into another vehicle on the road, you are creating a new Karma and you will have to pay for it.

Everything happening in the journey of life is because of twin Karma. It is a combination of our past and present actions. It depends on our past actions, over which we have no control, and our present actions, over which we have complete control. Therefore, it is both, our past and present actions that become the twin karma that determine the destiny of our life.

Therefore, Karma doesn't control our destiny. Twin Karma does. This means everything is not pre-destined or predetermined. We have a choice. By choosing our actions, we can change our destiny. We are not doomed with bad luck. We can change our tomorrow, if we choose right actions today. Unfortunately, we don't realize this simple truth.

Suppose, there are a lot of thorns in our garden but there are many fruits in the neighbour's garden, is this our bad luck? No, it simply reflects our bad Karma. If we had planted fruit trees, we too could have enjoyed the fruits but we must remember that if our past Karma has thorns, then we may have to face them. We must neither get discouraged nor demoralized because this past Karma belongs to us. Therefore, it is said that we should be very careful of our actions, our Karma.

Is God in charge of our destiny? This is another lie with which

we live and die. God has blessed us human beings with a free will to choose our Karma, our actions. But once we have performed Karma, we can't escape it. However, we have an opportunity with our present Karma to change that. If our past Karma is bad and our present Karma is also bad, then we are doomed. With good present Karma, we can negate bad Karma of the past. Who has decided the fate of our little pet dog, that lovely creature that wags its tail and gives us joy? Can we even imagine, how much it suffers, being born as a dog? Was that God's will? No! It is Karma.

We must be very clear about the cycle of Karma. It is our own actions that determine who we are born as and where. Birth is just a reaction. Our actions of today, will be responsible for our next birth, just as our actions are responsible for how long we will live on earth.

Many of us believe that death is pre-determined. Is death pre-destined? No! The Law of Karma is dynamic. We are born because of Karma but what will unfold in life and our death will depend on both our original Karma, our opening balance or *Prarabdha* and our current Karma or *Agami*. Therefore, whatever actions we are performing today, will be equally responsible for when and how we will die. It is Karma. Not just the past Karma of a previous life, but even the present Karma of this life, together are responsible for our present destiny, our death and our rebirth. Unfortunately, Karma has kept our past life history as a mystery. That is why we don't know who we were in our previous lives, but Karma knows. Karma is fully aware and responsible for everything that is unfolding in our life.

Sometimes, we face a tragedy, an accident and we curse the one we think has caused it. We even attribute the misery to God. When we realize the truth that everything is controlled by Karma, our own past actions, then, we will stop cursing, just as we will stop nursing and rehearsing what has happened. We will accept it as a reward or punishment for our own past deeds. We must be absolutely clear that everything and absolutely everything that is happening is this cycle of action and reaction. Birth is a reaction. Karma is

an action. Death is another reaction. Therefore, all our actions, all our Karma are the cause of both our birth and death. Our Karma decides how long we will have breath. Then, it is Karma that will decide whether we will return to earth and what will be our next birth.

If we realize that we are not the body, mind and ego, we are the Divine Soul, then, we are free from Karma. Will we be free from death? No, the body will die but we will be free from birth, another rebirth on earth. But for this, we must transcend Karma. If we continue to do Karma, be it good or bad, then, we are planting seeds through our deeds and ensuring that we will be back in the cycle of birth, Karma and death. Our goal is to intercept this cycle and break free from it, so that we can be liberated and united with the Divine. Alas, we don't realize this cycle and try to do good deeds, thinking that good Karma will make us attain God. When we learn the A to Z of Karma, we will let go of all Karma, so that we are free from all trauma of this drama and we attain *Moksha*.

27 TRANSCENDING KARMA

If we are caught in this cycle of Karma, death and birth, how can we escape from returning to earth? If each human being has no option but to perform action, where is the possibility of being free from the reaction? The reaction is inevitable and so is suffering. Then, what is it about being free from Karma, about transcending Karma? How is that even possible? Very few of us are blessed to understand, what is known as Liberation from Karma. Liberation from Karma does not mean that we will stop doing any action. It means, being free from all reaction. How can we do this?

To transcend Karma, we have to realize the truth that no doubt, the body does Karma but are we the body? No! If we believe that we are the body, then every action of ours is recorded as our Karma. Any action will have a reaction. The seed will bear fruit but what if we realize that we are not the body? Then, it is not our action. It is not our Karma. Let us think about any instrument of action. For instance, a gun. If we use a gun to shoot somebody, whose Karma is it? Is it the Karma of the gun that shot somebody dead or is it our Karma, the ones who used the gun to shoot? In this case, we will obviously say that the gun is just an instrument that has no life, so how can it be the Karma of the gun? But even if the gun had life, if it was not the gun that was responsible for the act, the Karma would belong to us and not the gun. The moment we realize that we are just an instrument and not the doer of action, the moment we realize that we are just the Soul and not the body, then it is no more our action, it is no more our Karma and we will not have to face the corresponding reactions of the actions that we do.

To transcend Karma, not only must we realize that our body is just an instrument and we are not this body that is doing the Karma, we must also realize that we are not the Mind and Ego, ME, that drives the body to act. Not only are we not the instrument of action but we are not even the director of action. This will liberate us from Karma.

The ME, the Mind and Ego, is the one that owns the Karma. The body will die but the Mind and Ego, ME, carries Karma, birth after birth, as it returns to earth. So, are we the mind and ego? If only we realize that we are not the mind, it is something that we cannot find, it is just a bundle of thoughts and further, if we realize that we are not the ego that keeps saying 'I', 'me' and 'mine', this ego is a false identity, then, we transcend ME, that owns Karma and we go beyond the three accounts of Karma. For this, we have to realize we are the Divine Soul and the Soul has no Karma. Then, although we may be alive in a body-mind complex, we become free from all Karma. We detach ourselves from what is unfolding for the human being that we are not. The human body is just an abode of the Soul. We are the Soul.

Imagine if we are in a car and the car has an accident and is badly damaged. Nothing happens to us. We are different from the car. We understand this clearly but we don't understand that we are different from the body. To transcend Karma, we must realize that we are neither the body nor the mind. Then, we are no more blind. We open our real eyes, as we realize the truth. This is the biggest Karmic secret that we must learn. As a result, we will stop earning Karma for every

deed that the body performs. The body will still continue to act but we will not react to whatever is happening. We will accept without protest, the Karma that is unfolding to the body-mind in which, we are a guest. We will disassociate ourselves with the drama of Karma and thus, we will be free from the trauma. But this is only possible for the one that transcends Karma. Otherwise, we will continue to suffer in this cycle of *Samsara*, the continuous cycle of Karma, of death and rebirth.

Although Karma seems to be a very simple Universal Law, only a small fraction of us understand this law and go beyond it. Very few of us are able to transcend Karma and attain *Moksha*, the very goal and purpose of human existence. But most of us just live and die, without realizing the truth of, 'Who am I?' When something happens, we cry. Then, after our death, we are blessed with new breath, in a new body, to experience pleasure and pain, again and again, based on our Karma. What should we seek? Should we seek to be caught in this drama of Karma or transcend it? Should we continue to live in ignorance and be a slave, till we reach our grave or should we be free from Karma? Let us not waste a moment in transcending Karma.



The Purpose and Goal of our Life is to Transcend Karma, Otherwise, we will Suffer Trauma and Return to the Drama.

28 LIVING AS A DIVINE INSTRUMENT If one has understood the A to Z of Karma, then he transcends Karma, goes beyond the Law of Action and Reaction and lives as a Divine instrument of the Lord. One does not seek any rewards for their Karma, although they do good deeds. They realize that they are the Divine Soul and not the body, mind and ego that they appear to be. Being enlightened with the truth, they become a Karma Yogi, one who is ever-united with the Divine, doing Karma as an offering to the Lord. When one seeks no fruits for the seeds that they are planting, their deeds are no more Karma. Their actions become Karma Yoga. This is possible only when one transcends the ego, when they let go of the 'I', when there is no ME, Mind and Ego, when the body is a mere instrument of action and when one becomes a Divine instrument.

What does it mean to live as a Divine instrument? Normally, we live as the body, mind and ego. We think, I am ME. Our life is subject to the Law of Karma. But the Karmic law applies to living creatures that are embodied, not to the Soul. On the Realization that I am a Soul, a Spark Of Unique Life, one is liberated from Karma. However, one is still alive and continues to perform actions. So, who is the one performing actions now? It is the Karma Yogi or the enlightened self, who is living a life of complete surrender, seeking nothing and doing everything for the Supreme, on behalf of the Supreme and as per the Divine Will.

A Karma Yogi has no desires. He transcends his passion and has only one obsession - to become one with the Divine. A Karma Yogi realizes, 'I am nothing'. I am not the body, mind

and ego that I appear to be. I am a manifestation of SIP, the Supreme Immortal Power. Therefore, his life is not his anymore. He has surrendered his life completely to the Lord. Therefore, he has become an instrument of God, whose every action is as per his Divine mission, till the last moment of his life.

Is a Karma Yogi free from all Karma? Yes, he is free from all his Karma and no more creates any fresh Karma because although he is living in a body, mind and ego complex, he is no more the *Karta* or the doer of an action. Therefore, his current account of Karma or *Agami* Karma is closed. He creates no new Karma, whatsoever. What about his *Prarabdha* Karma or the opening balance of Karma that he started with? A truly enlightened Karma Yogi is even free from *Prarabdha* Karma too. Although he is living in the body and it may appear that the body is receiving the Karma or the reaction of past action, the Karma Yogi is unaffected by this.

We are told of Sri Ramakrishna Paramahansa, Guru of Swami Vivekananda. He was an enlightened one and lived as a Divine instrument, a Karma Yogi. However, his body was inflicted with cancer and he would get spasms of pain. He would laugh intermittently, expressing how the body was being attacked but suffered no pain. It is not easy to live like Sri Ramakrishna Paramahansa, a real Karma Yogi. He had realized God and not only saw God in his disciple, Swami Vivekananda but could see God in every living creature, in every being. He gave up his life, realizing that he was nothing but a Divine instrument. Such enlightened people inspire us

to live as a Karma Yogi, becoming a Divine instrument of the Supreme.

A Karma Yogi is not only free from *Agami* and *Prarabdha* Karma, the current and opening accounts of Karma but is also free from *Sanchita* Karma that belongs to the Mind and Ego, ME. His Realization that the mind and ego is an illusion liberates him, not just from ignorance but from all Karma. In that ultimate moment when a Karma Yogi experiences death of the body, he is liberated from the cycle of rebirth. He does not return to earth. He attains *Moksha*, *Nirvana* or Salvation and becomes one with the Lord.

Can we all be Karma Yogis? Yes, we can. Becoming a Karma Yogi or a Divine instrument must reflect in our life and our actions. We cannot just say that we are a Karma Yogi. We have to realize that we are nothing but the Soul, a particle of SIP, the Supreme. Having realized this, every action of ours must be driven by the Divine Will. Only when we hand over the control of our life to the Supreme and every act of ours is directed by the Lord, we will be completely free from Karma and this drama.

29 LIFE IS KARMA



Having traversed the journey of Karma, A to Z, what is the ultimate Realization? It is this – Life is Karma. Everything in life is Karma. There is no Karma without life, just as there is no life without Karma. Anybody who is alive faces Karma. Our birth is because of Karma. We did not come to earth for nothing. We arrived on the planet because of our past Karma. Once we are born, we have to do Karma. We can neither be free from doing Karma nor can we be free from our past Karma. All the deeds that we have done in all previous lives that have not been redeemed, all such unsettled Karma will return to us, one by one. Whether they are good or bad, we cannot escape from Karma.

In fact, nobody can escape Karma. We may belong to any religion or any nationality but we are all subject to the Karmic Law. No just human beings, every living creature seems to be under the purview of Karma. Karma is the essential law that governs all existence. If there was no Karma, life on this planet would cease to be. Just as there are Universal Laws, the Law of Gravity that keep our feet grounded on the street and the Law of Cycles causes rotation of the earth and creates day and night, there is the Law of Action and Reaction that ensures the drama called life, continues to go on and on.

Unfortunately, while most of us understand Karma and even surrender to the law, we do not realize that the purpose of life is to transcend Karma. The very purpose of our existence is Liberation from Karma and Unification with the Divine. We are not meant to take birth on earth, just to do Karma, to suffer and be rewarded by Karma, to live, die and return to earth in a

rebirth. Our purpose is to realize we are not the body, mind and ego but the Divine Soul. How many of us realize that Life is Karma and that our purpose is to realize the truth of this drama, become free from all trauma of the body, mind and ego and ultimately, attain *Moksha*?

There will be a few who will be ignorant about Karma or even indifferent towards the principles of this boomerang law. When things go wrong in their life, they will just cry and question, 'Why?' They will just live, die and will be reborn. This will go on and on. But the one who realizes the truth, the A to Z of Karma, becomes a Karma Yogi who lives as a Divine instrument. Only such an enlightened being is liberated from all suffering on earth. Such a realized Soul is not only free from Karma but attains the goal of realizing that he is a manifestation of the Divine. He imagines himself to be like a remote-control car with the remote control being in the hands of the Divine. Not only does he live a life of complete acceptance, he also surrenders his life completely and has no expectations.

One who has realized the truth of Karma continues to live in the body-mind complex but is liberated from Karma. It may seem that the Karma Yogi is doing Karma but in reality, he is not. Karma is being done by his body and directed by the Lord.

Not only is life, Karma but even death is because of our Karma. Coming to the planet and departing from existence are both under the control of Karma. Therefore, if you remove Karma, there will be no life itself. Our goal is to be free from all Karma. We must not imagine that doing good Karma will take

us to heaven, where we will be rewarded. This is the biggest lie. Of course, we must do good deeds, for bad deeds will make us suffer but we must go beyond good deeds and beyond Karma, if we want *Nirvana* or *Moksha*. We must realize that Karma is an earthly law but we want to discover the heavenly truth, the truth that we are not the body, mind and ego that does the Karma. We are the Divine Soul.

Before we close, let us remember that only man is blessed to attain God. No other creature can realize the truth about Karma. All other living beings will experience trauma but only man can be free from all misery on earth and from rebirth. It is only man who can attain *Moksha*. All living creatures must return as per their Karma to a life of a human being. It is a human being who is exclusively blessed with a fully developed intellect, to discriminate and through his willpower, he can make a choice to transcend all Karma, realizing the truth of life. Having been born as a human, if we do not realize the A to Z of Karma and we just live and die, then, we will be reborn and this will go on and on. Let us transcend Karma and trauma in this drama and attain *Moksha*.



Life is Karma, Karma controls this Earthly Drama! Our Goal is to be free from all Trauma and attain Moksha!



1. Do all our actions create Karma?

The Law of Karma is called by this name only because it is a law of action. Therefore, yes, each and every action of ours, good or bad, is recorded and creates Karma or an automatic reaction that will come back to us corresponding to our deeds, good or bad.

2. People believe that everything that happens is predestined, then how are we responsible for our Karma?

While there is no doubt that Karma creates some amount of a predestined life, it does not deprive us of the opportunity to choose our actions and create fresh Karma. Our past actions determine several aspects of our predestined present life. Our gender, date of birth, place of birth and parents are some aspects of our predestined life that our past Karmas create. However, our actions are not predestined. Only our circumstances are. Whatever is happening around us is

predestined due to our past Karma, but what action we take depends on our own choice, our own free will and thereafter, we are responsible for our present actions and our destiny.

3. Can our Guru or a Saint wipe off our Karma?

Our Guru and a Saint can lead us to good Karma. He can also guide us to be liberated from the cycle of death and rebirth. But the Guru cannot remove our Karmas. Nobody in this world can remove our Karma except us. These are our Karma, and we have to negate them.

4. Can our balance of Karma be reduced or lessened? If yes, what is the way?

Since Karma is generally referred to as our bad deeds, our bad deeds can only be reduced or lessened by the good deeds that we perform. Although some people believe that we cannot negate bad deeds with good deeds, definitely they can be reduced by our good deeds.

5. Are mentally imbalanced people free from creating fresh Karma as they do not have a discriminative mind or intellect?

Nobody can define the Law of Karma exactly. We can only imagine and make probable inferences. The principle of Karma is that anybody who is in command of their actions with a discriminating mind is responsible for their Karma. Therefore, it is said that children whose mind is not

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developed do not create Karma, nor do animals because they live by instinct and not by intellectual discrimination. The same could hold true for mentally challenged people as well.

6. Do the Masters or realized Souls create Karma?

Everybody who is alive creates Karma. However, Spiritual Masters or realized Souls do not create Karma because they do not believe that they are doing anything. They have realized that they are not the ego, the mind and the body. They exist in a body-mind complex but all their actions are performed by the Lord. They act as an instrument of God. They surrender all their actions as an offering to God. And thus, they do not create Karma. They are liberated.

7. Since the pain of suffering people is part of their Karma, are we interfering with Karma if we try to relieve their suffering?

When we help a suffering person, we should not worry about what their Karma is. We should only be concerned about what Karma we are creating. Therefore, being compassionate, serving the poor and the suffering can only create good Karma for us. It is wrong to think that by helping those who are suffering, we are interfering in their Karma.

8. If good actions also create good Karma that causes our

rebirth, should we also give up doing good Karma?

The common sense answer is no. We should not give up doing good Karma because basically human beings cannot live without action. We have to act. Therefore, if we have two choices – to do bad Karma or do good Karma, our common sense tells us to do good Karma. But this question goes one step further. Since good Karma causes rebirth, should we give up the good Karma? If we give up good Karmas then what would we do? We can't do anything. We have to do something. So we must do good Karma rather than bad Karma. However, we must remember – while we do good Karma, we must not do good Karma as the doer. We must do good Karma only as an instrument of the Lord, acting on the Lord's behalf. Our Karma should not be egoistic. Our Karma should be doing God's work, surrendering that work and presenting that work to the Lord at His lotus feet, as an offering.

9. Does the Law of Karma operate eye for an eye?

Karma is a law of compensation and redemption. However, nobody truly knows whether our bad deeds will be returned with a mirror reaction by Karma, or we will face a worse or a milder reaction. Karma is a law of the Cosmic Creator, and we have not been given the ability to comprehend how the law exactly works. We can understand the law by inference. We have some indication of how the law works. But we cannot be exactly sure how the law works. However, since it is a law of

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action and reaction, cause and effect, redemption and compensation, there is no doubt that there would be an eye for an eye in that sense till we are liberated from Karma.

10. We are forced to react to certain practical situations in Life. For instance, when a mosquito or any insect starts biting us, we immediately react to the extent of killing it. Will the above deed account for creating Karma?

It is said that the Law of Karma works with certain reasonable principles. So, for instance, if there is a snake that's trying to attack you and kill you, you have every right to protect your life -that is your duty. But if a mosquito is about to bite you, you can always avoid it by batting it away, or prevent it by using certain mosquito repellants or by keeping the room clean. When you realize that life is nothing but God, then you don't kill, you don't take life. You avoid killing anything. But in cases where it is unavoidable, then we have to do what our intellect tells us to do. Whether we create negative Karma or not depends on the deed. If our act is an act of cruelty, an act of indifference or an act of murder, definitely we will create negative Karma. On the other hand, if our act is an act of self-defence, an act that is justified, then there is no negative Karma.

11. Do animals acquire Karma?

Animals are known to be creatures of instinct and not of intellect. Therefore, they go into the category of innocent

children. They do not create Karma because they are not using their body and mind that is directed by their ego. While they do not create Karma, they are definitely redeeming Karma of their past life as they live.

12. Do we incur negative Karma even if we hurt someone unintentionally?

If we hurt someone unintentionally, the negative Karma that we create might be of a smaller nature. A smaller negative debit will be put in our account of Karma. But definitely, every time we hurt somebody, it is certainly adding a negative Karma in our account.

13. Why do we need to take another birth to pay the Karma of a past life?

Since the Creator has created the universe in such a way that we are born and we die, the Karma account is not settled. Not only is the Karma account not settled for this life, we carry Karmic accounts for several lives. The only way to settle the score is to be reborn again and again. Rebirth fits in perfectly with the Law of Karma because we can be born in a life of happiness or a life of misery based on our past Karma. That way we are able to negate our bad deeds or are rewarded for the good ones and so continues the Law of Karma.

14. Is life all about clearing our Karma baggage?

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For normal people, yes, life is all about clearing our negative Karma. We live and we die to extinguish our Karma, to redeem our Karma and to compensate our Karma. But to a realized soul, life is not about clearing Karma. Life is about realizing the truth that we are not the body and the mind complex that creates Karma. We are the Divine Soul. Once we realize that, there is no Karma as we are liberated.

15. Is our life scripted, pre-destined or pre-decided? Why do sometimes some significant things happen to us? Is it faith or luck or serendipity?

If we believe that our life is scripted or pre-destined, we are living a life of illusion. Our life is not pre-destined or predecided. No doubt, our past Karma is written and etched in stone and we can't change the results of it. Whatever is unfolding in our life, our situations and circumstances are our own past Karma that is returning to us, one by one. But is our entire life scripted? Is the storyboard of the drama of our life, fixed? No, it is not. To understand this, we must understand the concept of Twin Karma. Twin Karma is a combination of past as well as present Karma. We have no control over our past Karma because they are already done. The second Karma is the present actions that we do. We have willpower, we have intellect, we can discriminate, and we can choose our present actions as a part of our free will. Both our past and present Karma, together, script our destiny. Our destiny is not predetermined. It is in our hands. We can decide, choose and

attain the destiny of our choice. Therefore, everything happening in this world is because of Karma. There is nothing like luck, coincidence or faith in God. Faith in God is Karma in itself. We must understand that things unfold in the life of an individual as per their Twin Karma.

16. What is Karma Yoga and who is a Karma Yogi?

We can transcend our Karma by attaining Enlightenment, by the Realization of the Truth. But even after attaining Enlightenment, one can't eliminate their Karma. Karma means action. So, as long as one is alive, the body, mind and ego must act. We cannot remain in a state of inaction, forever. So, how do you go beyond Karma? You can experience, what is known as, freedom 'in' action and not freedom 'from' action. To experience freedom from Karma, one has to realize that I am not the one who is doing the Karma, I am not the body that acts and I am not the mind and ego, ME, that drives the body. I am the Divine Soul. Once you realize that you are that, not this, you are in a state of Karma Yoga. You become a Karma Yogi, the one who is united with the Divine all the time. Your action is to act like an instrument of the Divine. So, all your purpose are surrendered to the Divine. None of the actions are yours.

Karma Yoga means doing Karma or work as Yoga, being in union with the Divine. A Karma Yogi acts as an instrument of God. He realizes that he is like a flute, just an instrument. He doesn't create the music but music is created through him. It is

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God that does all that he does. Therefore, in Karma Yoga, there is no expectation of any fruit or results from actions. Every action is surrendered to the Divine as an offering, just as one would offer worship or prayer. Karma Yoga is not the action of a body and mind, it is the action of an instrument of the Divine. Therefore, in a state of Karma Yoga, the Karma Yogi creates no Karma.

17. Can we know how much total Karma is there for me to redeem? Can a Guru help me with transcending all my Karma?

Karma has three accounts. The first one is *Prarabdha* Karma or the opening balance. This is the Karmic Account that we bring with ourselves in a birth. So, whatever situations and circumstances are there during our birth and early lifetime, are due to our Prarabdha Karma. The second account of Karma is Agami Karma or the current account. This is an account of our present actions or deeds. The third account is a corpus account called Sanchita Karma. This is a corpus account that stores all our unredeemed Karma across all the lifetimes that we have lived. At the time of our birth, some unredeemed Karma is chosen from the corpus or Sanchita account and sent as Prarabdha or the opening balance. The Law of Karma is a Universal Law that decides our Prarabdha Karma. We, human beings, cannot know how much Karma is left for us to redeem. A Guru cannot touch your Sanchita or Prarabdha Karma because they are sealed. A Guru can only help you in your *Agami* Karma, the present deeds. Your past Karma is beyond the purview of a Guru. Even God does not interfere in it. So, what is the role of a Guru? A Guru has a profound role in helping us overcome our ignorance and be enlightened to realize the truth. With the grace of the Guru, we can drop all our Karma – *Sanchita, Agami* and *Prarabdha*. All the Karma across lifetimes drops like a bag of potatoes into an ocean and sinks because of a Guru's grace. A Guru helps us to realize that we are neither the body nor the mind or the ego that carries the Karma. Because of Guru, we can be liberated from all Karma and be united with God.

18. I had a recurring thought to take revenge on someone who did grave injustice to me. Does it mean that I have accrued negative Karma?

The word Karma means 'action'. Action is not thought. We may have a hundred thoughts but they don't become our Karma. When a thought becomes a feeling and that feeling becomes an action, only then, it becomes our Karma. We can take two types of examples to explain this. Suppose, we have a hundred sinful thoughts and we defeat every sinful thought that comes to our mind with our intellect and Consciousness and don't act on them. Then, we have prevented accumulating bad Karma. Opposite to the previous example, sometimes, we may have some great ideas to serve people, be compassionate and doing good work but are unable to implement them. Then, those ideas remain as ideas and

thoughts. Will we get the fruit for thinking good? No! We know that we won't. Therefore, Karma is not a thought. Karma is action. What you sow, so shall you reap. What you do, will come back to you. Whatever you think, good or bad, that could not be converted to actions, will not reap any fruits.

19. If there is *Prarabdha* Karma and everything that is unfolding in our life is due to our past Karma, then, what is the use of free will?

Whatever we are experiencing on earth in this birth is due to our past actions or Prarabdha Karma but our mind prevents us from understanding, where this past Karma comes from. It comes from our free will. If there was no free will, where would the past Karma come from? It was our free will that caused our past Karma, Prarabdha and whatever that is unfolding in our life, now. Similarly, our free will, now, will choose our present Karma that will lead to our future destiny. We will pave a path for whatever is going to happen 'tomorrow' through the Karma of 'today'. Suppose we are moving on in the road of life in our car. The path or the situation is already laid out in front of us. This is the result of our past Karma or Prarabdha but we will still hold the steering of the car and can turn in any direction as we wish. This is our free will. Unfortunately, our mind wants us to remain in ignorance and not realize the simple truth that our life is a combination of free will, present Karma or Agami Karma and the unfolding of the past Karma or Prarabdha that we call, destiny.

20. Should we believe in Karma?


Karma is a Universal Law. We have no option but to believe in the Law of Karma that works on the principle, 'As you sow, so, shall you reap.' Don't we believe that if we plant mangoes, we will get mangoes and not apples? Yes, we believe and have to accept it too. Therefore, irrespective of the fact that we believe in Karma or not, the law will operate. The Law of Karma governs the universe. Everything and every organism in this world is under the purview of this law. If you don't believe that there will be day or night tomorrow, will the day or night stop happening? No, absolutely not. Just because you don't believe in sunrises and sunsets, will the sun stop rising and setting? No! Sunrise and sunset, day and night occur promptly and on their due time and interval every day due to the Law of Cycles, whether we believe it or not. So also, there is the Law of Karma or the Law of Action and Reaction. Therefore, there is no question of whether we should believe in it or not. We must to accept, have faith and comply with the Law of Karma and believe that what you do, will come back to you.

Every action and every word,

Done alone or done in a herd,

Whatever we do is ours to keep,

If not in this life, in the next we will reap.



My journey with Karma has evolved over the last few years. I believed Karma to be a law that said, 'What you do, will come back to you' but as I explored the Divine law that governs the universe, I realized that everything that is happening in life is Karma. What we do in life is not because our previous Karma is making us do that particular thing. It is because of our free will. But people don't realize this. It is our free will, our choice and this will create Karma. Once we create Karma, it unfolds. Therefore, everything that is unfolding in life, absolutely everything that is happening is because of Karma. Nothing happens by chance. There is no such thing as bad luck. My Realizations about Karma have made me live in complete acceptance, without any protest, whatsoever.

I also realized that what I do, is in my hands. So, I do my best. I let the Divine do the rest. Once I have done everything to the best of my capability, I just surrender. I know that *whatever will be, will be.* Nothing can change it.

In the beginning, my life was full of prayer, prayer in its most common form. I depended so much on Divine intervention to make sure my life is full of peace and bliss. But as life evolved, prayer evolved and my understanding of God, changed.

Who is God? God is SIP, the Supreme Immortal Power. Who am I? I am a Soul, a Spark Of Unique Life. My Self-Realization that I am not 'I', liberated me from Karma. I was neither the doer of action, the body nor the director of action, the Mind and Ego, ME. I was a Divine Soul. I started to live as a Divine instrument, realizing that I do nothing. Everything is done by SIP through me.

Over the last 5 years, I have written about 65 books. Normally, it takes two or three years to write a book. Where then, does this grace come from, to write a new book a month? It is SIP that uses me as an instrument. I have written around 1400 songs on life, *Bhajans* or *Jeevan Sangeet*, without any professional training. It seems that I sing but I realized that I do not sing. SIP makes me sing. In everything I do, in my Spiritual journey, whether it is recording videos, doing live talks, even answering questions on the internet or going live on Zoom, I am always conscious and aware of the truth that I do nothing. Therefore, all that I do, I do not. SIP does. And so, it is not my Karma. I am not expecting any fruits or rewards for my actions. My actions are all an offering to SIP, that makes me do what I do. Thus, my life has evolved from doing good Karma to living as a Karma Yogi.

As a Karma Yogi, I am constantly in Yoga, moving from one state of Yoga to another, from *Dhyana* Yoga to *Bhakti* Yoga to *Gyana* Yoga to Karma Yoga and finally, *Prema* Yoga. All these

states of Yoga, be it meditation or devotion, education or action, help me live transcending the Mind and Ego, ME, that would otherwise take ownership of the Karma and get caught in the web of *Samsara*, the cycle of death and rebirth.

Today, I am blessed to realize the truth about Karma. I guide people on several important aspects and help them be enlightened with the truth that good Karma will not help us attain God. If we do good Karma, we will be ever separated from the Divine, as we are reborn, again and again. To realize God, we have to let go of the ego. Unless we realize, I am not 'I', I am the Soul, I do nothing, SIP does everything, we will never transcend Karma and achieve our ultimate goal of living as the Divine Soul.

This is the purpose of my life. To be liberated from earth, from rebirth and be united with the Divine. We must be free from *Maya*, the Cosmic Illusion, from *Leela*, the Divine drama and attain that state of *Moksha*, *Nirvana* or Salvation. I realized that as long as I had an active Karmic account, my *Prarabdha* Karma, the opening balance, *Agami* Karma, the current account and *Sanchita* Karma, the warehouse or corpus, it would continue to bind me on earth but the moment I realize the truth, I would be free from all Karma.

Realization of the truth about Karma was one of the major aspects of my Spiritual Enlightenment. Thereafter, I have lived as a Karma Yogi, a Divine instrument to become one with SIP. Today, I live in a state of Eternal Bliss and peace, the

state of *SatChitAnanda*, just as I continue on my life mission to help people transcend their Karma and be free from all suffering on earth and rebirth.
